Chinese Language Summer Program

The **FIRST** joint Mandarin language summer program between the Confucius Institute for Business London (CIBL) and the leading university in China—Tsinghua University is now open for applications.

1. Time and Course Duration

- Starting time: 29th June 2009
- Duration: 3 weeks (Finishes on 17th July) or 8 weeks (Finishes on 21st August)

2. Program Fees (in RMB Yuan) and Scholarship

(1) Tuition: RMB 1,000 Yuan / week (Tuition, Extracurricular cultural activities in and around Beijing, Textbooks, Airport pick-up service: Group-arrivals ONLY)

NOTE: A deposit (20% of tuition) is required on reservation.

(2) Accommodation: (In Tsinghua University accommodation for overseas students)

- Single room: RMB 150 Yuan/day (air conditioning, Internet, ensuite)
- Double room: RMB 80 Yuan/person/day

(3) Scholarship: All applicants can apply for the **Confucius Institute Scholarship**. Please check the IBL website for detailed information :

3. Application Materials

Applicants must submit application materials (in duplicate) to the CIBL office (**G11, 20 Kingsway**) according to following requirements:

(1) Printed copy of the completed Application Form. The form can be downloaded from the Tsinghua ICLCC website <http://hanyu.tsinghua.edu.cn/testing/apply.html>

(2) A photocopy of the passport page with your photo on it

(3) 20% deposit according to length of course

4. Application Deadline: 8th May 2009

NOTE: Students number are limited on this special program . We will admit summer

program applicants on a "first come, first served" basis.

5. Introduction to ICLCC

The Tsinghua University International Chinese Language & Culture Center (ICLCC) gives students from all over the world an opportunity to learn Chinese at one of China's most famous and influential universities and among some of the world's most respected scholars. Founded in 1988, and located in the capital city of China, the center has become the main gateway for foreign institutions to establish and develop academic partnerships with Tsinghua University and the School of Humanities and Social Sciences. 6. Courses to be Offered

In order to accurately assess the Chinese proficiency of new students, ICLCC arranges a placement exam at the beginning of each term. Students will then be assigned to appropriate class levels in accordance with their proficiency in Chinese.

The curriculum of the program includes the following courses: Speaking, Listening Skills, Reading comprehension, Newspaper Reading, Grammar, Classical Chinese, Chinese History, Hot Topics, Writing, Pronunciation, and China in Modern Times. The program delivers 20 class hours per week, 5 days per week.

ICLCC also offers elective courses which include Chinese Calligraphy, Chinese Painting, Chinese Songs, Tai Chi, Chinese Martial Arts, etc.
