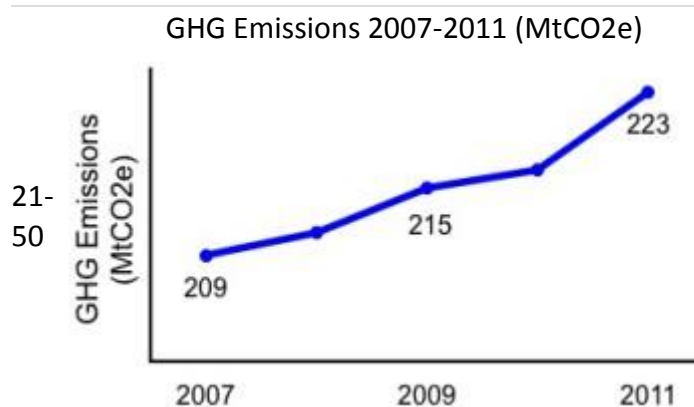


## Emissions

### Policies - Promotion of low-carbon energy (inc. renewables)

The sale of electricity from wind energy, biomass or agricultural waste is to be exempted from income tax for 15 years; Promote the use of non-conventional renewable energy sources (FNCER)

Programme for the Rational Use of Energy and the Use of Renewable Forms of Energy (PROURE)
