INTRODUCTION TO THE MPA

The MPA is an interdisciplinary degree devised to meet the demand from government departments and public agencies across the world for highly skilled and professional policy-makers. It also meets the needs of people who aspire to work at a high level in the private sector with governments, including consultancy, public-private partnerships, public affairs, media, non-governmental organisations and interest groups.

The programme is taught over two academic years, bringing together LSE's unrivalled expertise in the social sciences with individual and group working experience of public sector problems, policies and management. In the first year, students take a set of core courses in political science, economics and quantitative methods, which develop the skills required for in depth political and economic analysis. During their second year, students work in groups on a Capstone project in which they advise a public sector organisation, international body or private sector consultancy on a current policy challenge. Students choose option courses (electives) and also have the option to prepare a 10,000 word dissertation or a 6,000 word policy paper. Students take additional courses specific to the MPA stream in which they choose to specialise.
