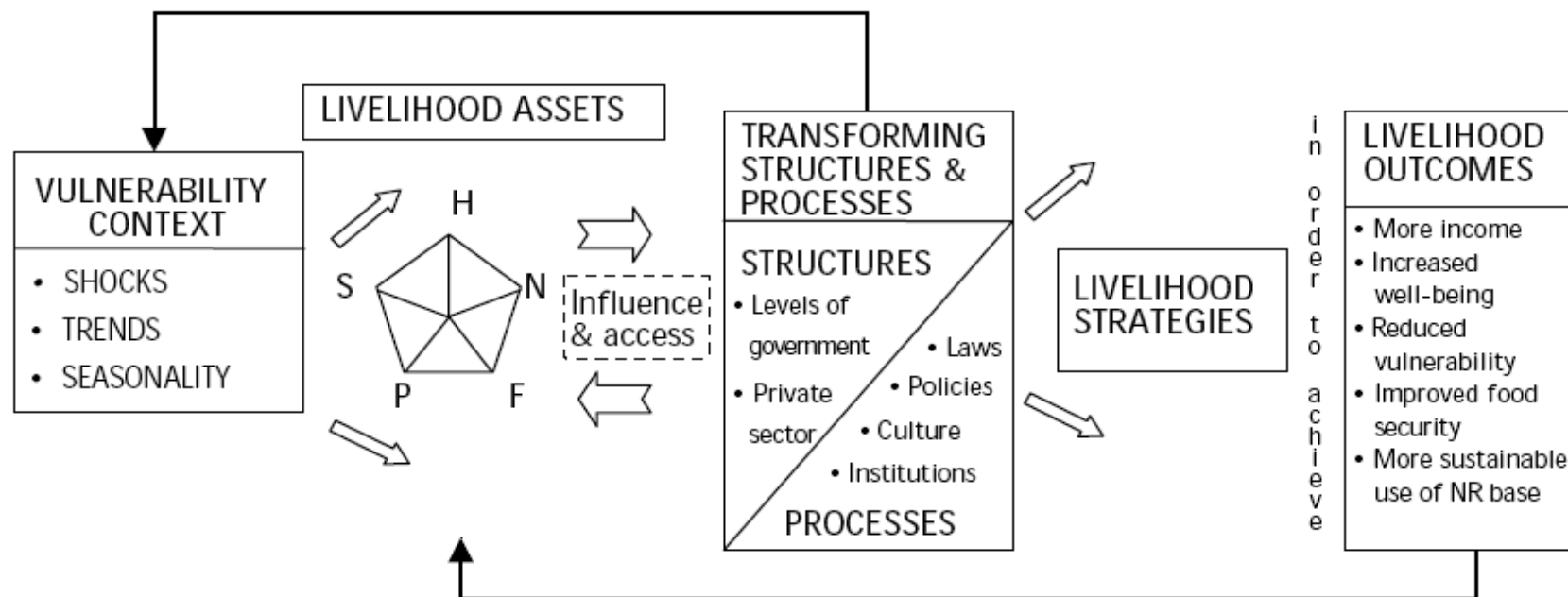

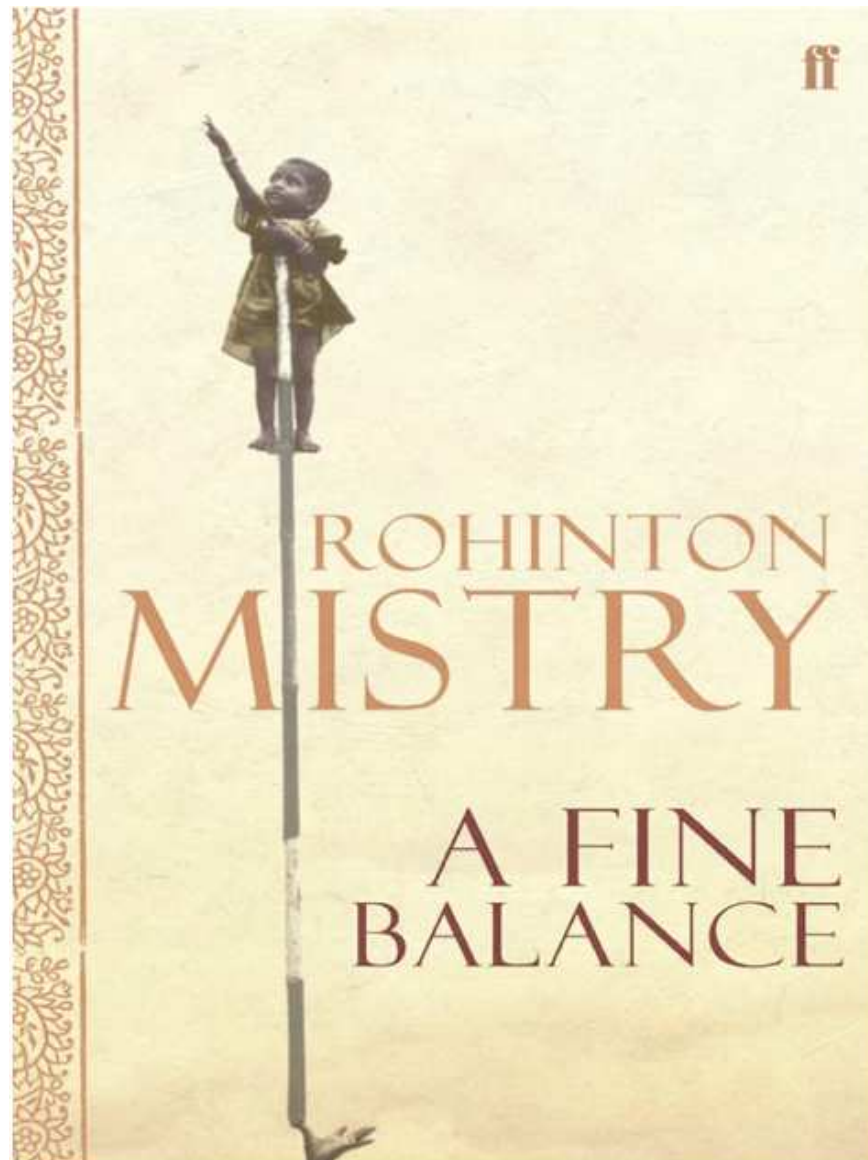


Figure 1. Sustainable livelihoods framework

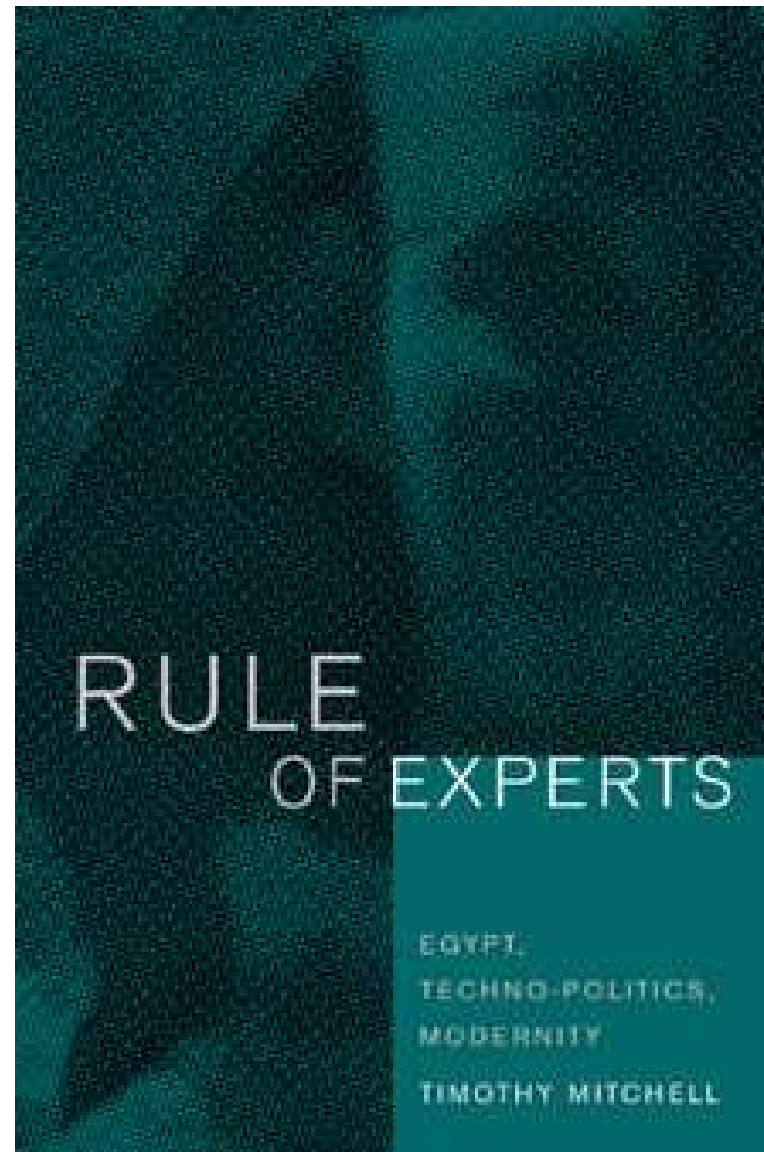

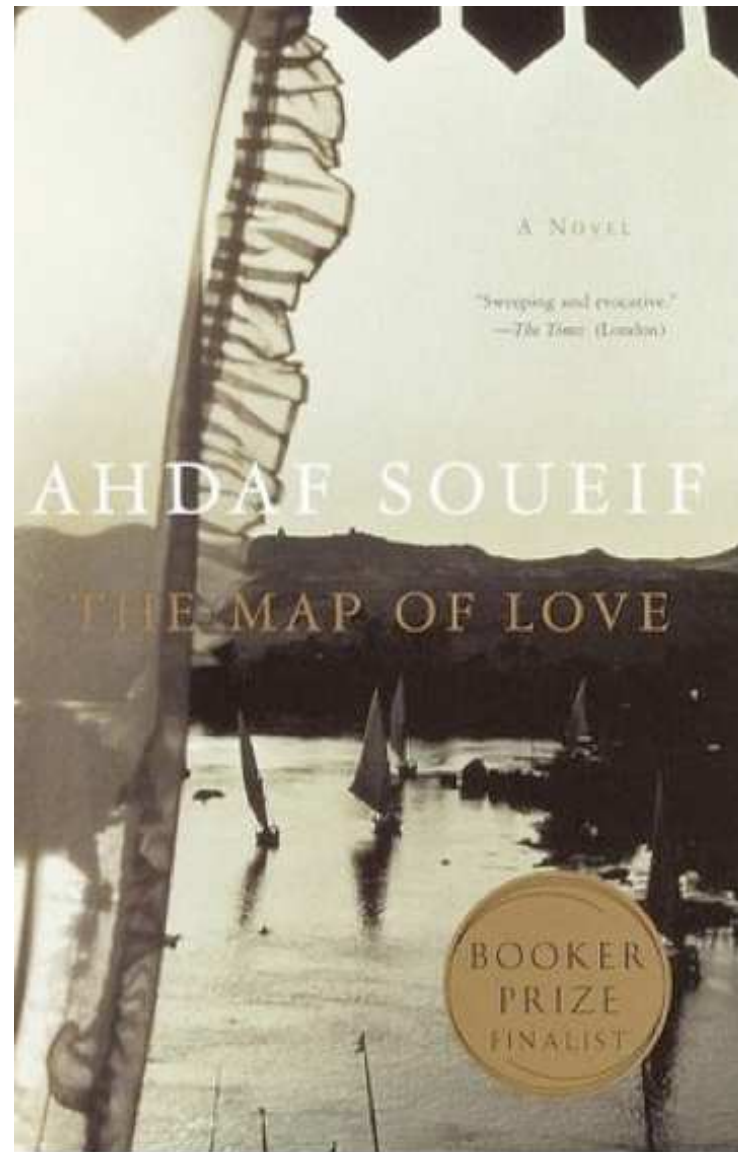
H = Human Capital      S = Social Capital

 F = Financial Capital









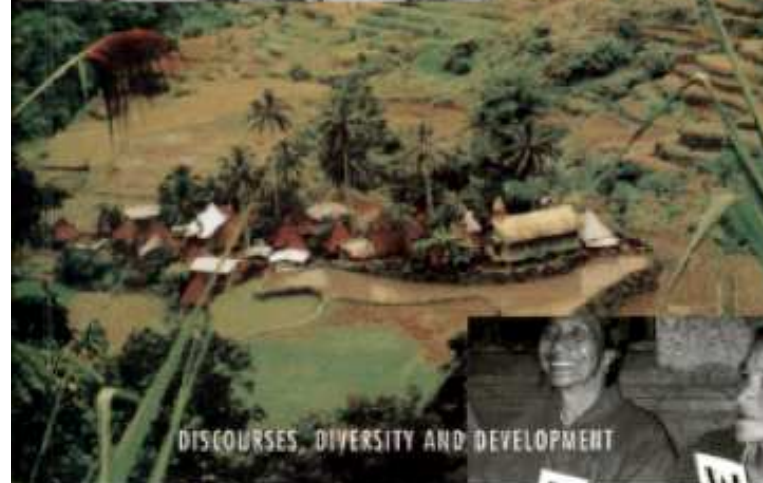

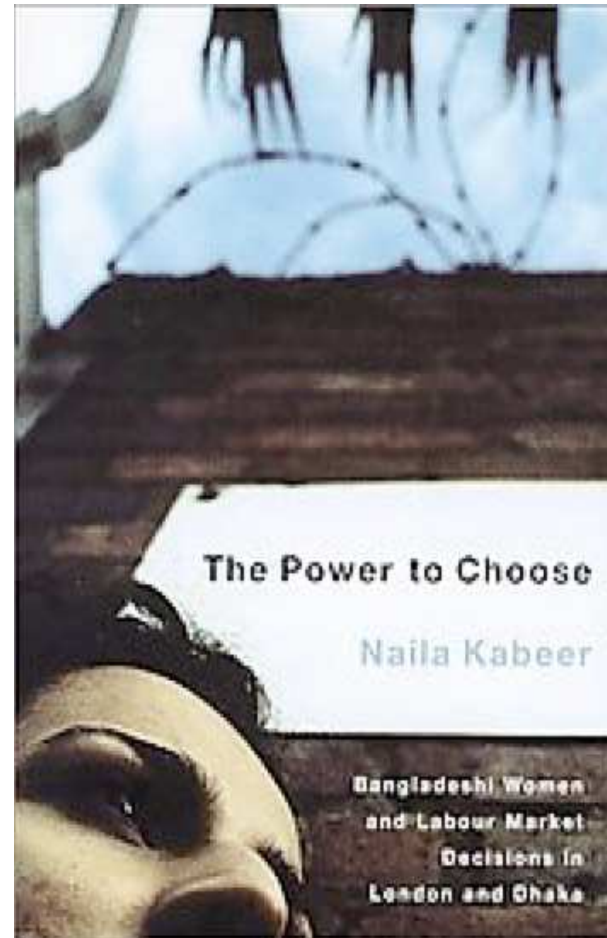
