

## iCHANNEL - 2<sup>nd</sup> Call for Papers

As information and communication technologies continue to diffuse and penetrate into different aspects of social life, scholarly research around it spreads to different academic disciplines. In many cases, researchers combine perspectives from different disciplines in order to analyze the complexities of development and use of these technologies. Indeed, for many, the sheer volume of inter-disciplinary research on ICTs is a testimony to the extent of change brought about by these technologies and an indication of the need to reconsider traditional boundaries between disciplines to find new ways of understanding and shaping technological trends. In line with this understanding, iCHANNEL, now in its fifth year of publication, invites researchers from different disciplines to submit their papers for the 2010 issue of this journal.

iCHANNEL is a student journal of information system, based at the Information Systems and Innovation Group (ISIG) of the Department of Management, London School of Economics. It is primarily interested in the social study of ICT but researches from other perspectives are equally acceptable as long as they involve ICT at the core of their study.

Different types of submissions are welcome for this issue; research papers, critical reviews of literature and theoretical discussions. Also, authors can jointly submit discussion papers on a contemporary debate around ICT, each making the case for one side or the other.

### Submission Requirements

- Manuscripts should be approximately 3,000 words (corresponding to 5 printed pages), including the title, abstract and references. Joint discussion papers should not be more than 2000 words each.
- All manuscripts have to be submitted in Word or PDF format.
- Manuscripts should be typed, double-spaced with 1" (2.5 cm) margins, and submitted in Times or Times New Roman 12-pt font.
- No material will be considered for publication if it is currently under consideration by another journal or press or if it has been published or is soon to be published elsewhere.
- Contributors are responsible for obtaining permission to reproduce any material in which they do not own copyright.

### How to submit your paper

- Only electronic submission (i.e. via e-mail) is acceptable
- Email subject should read like: Paper Surname pNo. (e.g. Paper Gates 2).
- Email body should include:
  - Full Name
  - Programme and Department (Alumni provide graduation year as well)
  - Title, Keywords, Word count (excl. reference)
