

Timetabling for Intercollegiate Courses 2007-8

In addition to teaching at the LSE, the department also makes some use of lectures offered by the University of London (at University College – UCL, Kings College – KCL or Birkbeck), known as intercollegiate teaching.

Intercollegiate lectures start in the week beginning 1 October 2007 (Term 1) and in the week beginning 7 January 2008 (Term 2).
