Three exciting developments relating to the Personal Social Services Research Unit (PSSRU) at the London School of Economics and Political Science are taking place on 1 July 2019.

● NAME CHANGE

To better reflect the growing scope of our research, which spans long-term care, mental health, developmental disabilities and other health issues, we are changing our name. From 1 July, we will be named the Care Policy and Evaluation Centre (CPEC).

CPEC (formerly PSSRU at LSE) is one of the strongest social care research centres in the UK and internationally, and it will continue to build on its many achievements over the last 23 years at LSE.

● CHANGE OF DIRECTOR

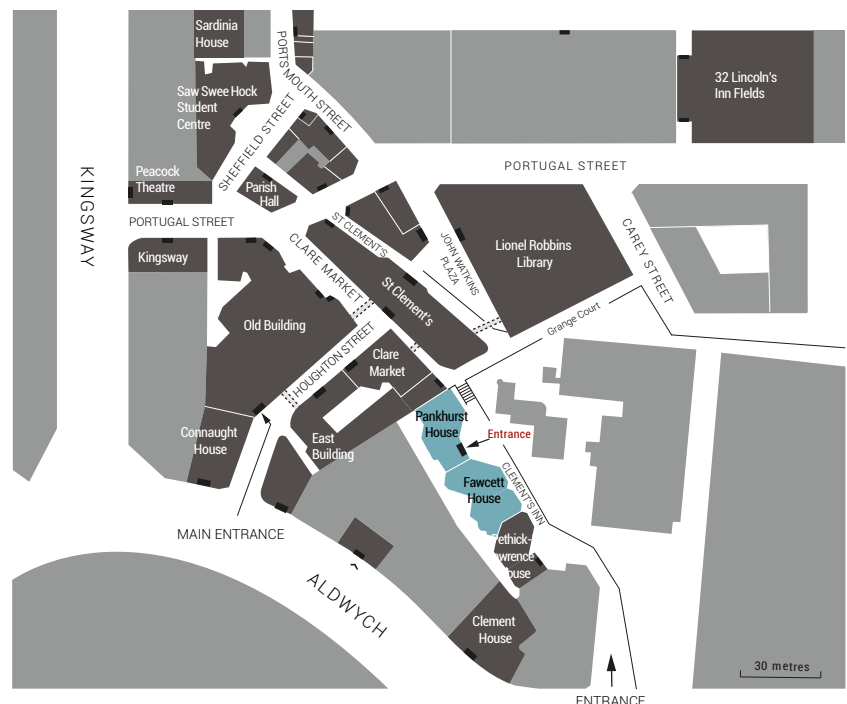
CPEC will be directed by Jose-Luis Fernandez, currently Deputy Director of PSSRU at LSE. The current director – Martin Knapp – will be stepping down to focus on research activities within CPEC and on the directorship of the NIHR School for Social Care Research (NIHR SSCR).

● RELOCATION

CPEC and its affiliated groups – NIHR SSCR, the NIHR Policy Research Unit in Adult Social Care (ASCRU) and the International Long-term Care Policy Network (ILPN) – will be located on the 8th floor of Pankhurst House and the 5th floor of Fawcett House (accessed via Pankhurst House).

Pankhurst and Fawcett Houses are just off the Aldwych next to the Royal Courts of Justice.
