Dr. Filippaios is currently the Director for PG Development and Accreditations and a Senior Lecturer in International Business. Previously he was the International MBA Course Director at Kingston Business School, Kingston University London holding the responsibility for all international MBA programmes offered by Kingston University London, in Russia, Greece, Cyprus and India.
