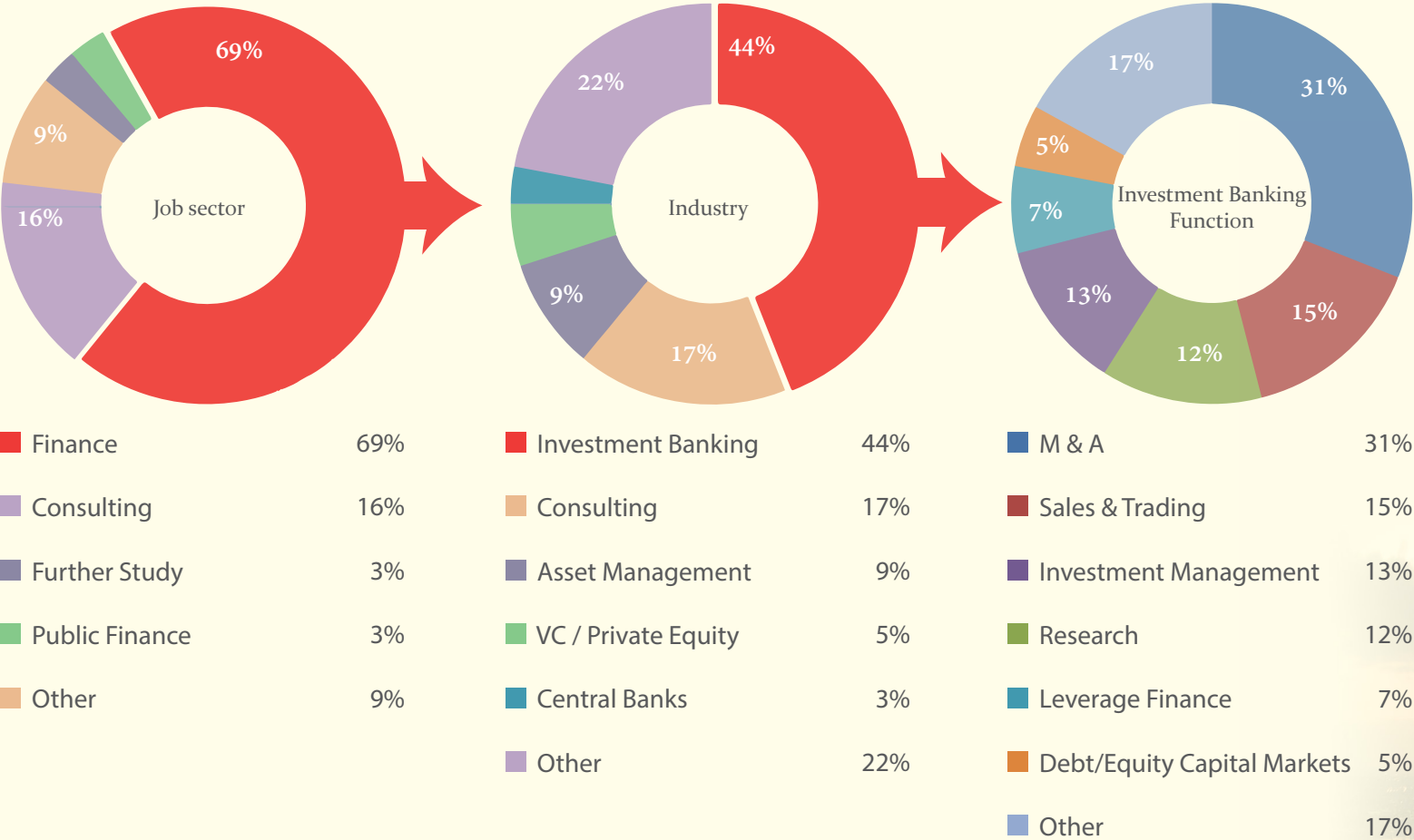


2014/15 class profile

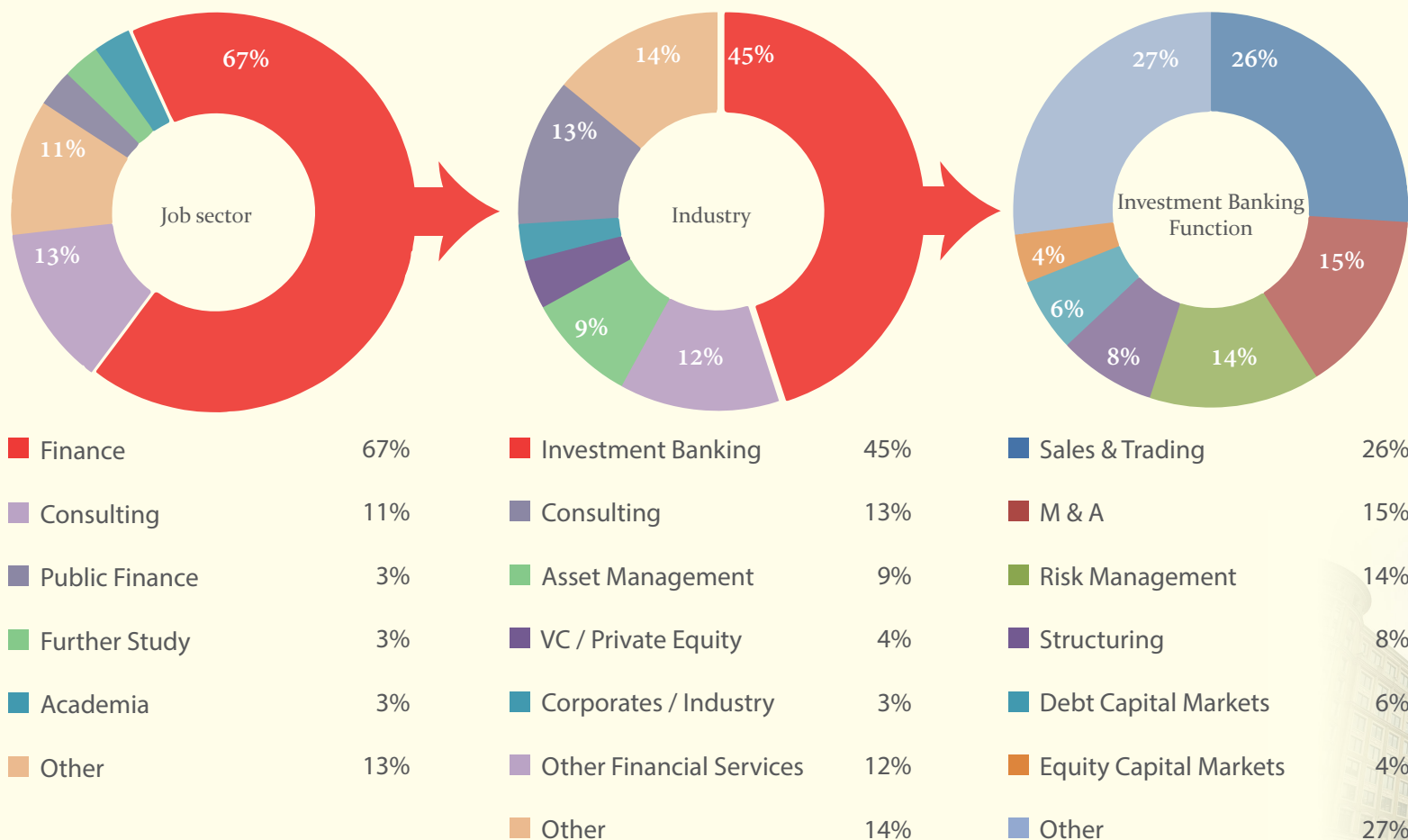

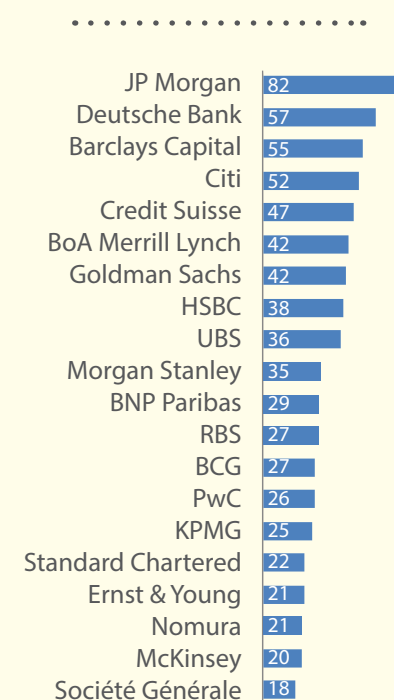
