He has been Assistant Secretary for Western Hemisphere Affairs at the US State Department under **President Obama**, and before that, Special Assistant to the President and Senior Director for Inter-American Affairs at the National Security Council, as well as Deputy Assistant Secretary for Inter-American Affairs, under **President Clinton**.

He founded the Center for Latin American Studies at Georgetown University and before that headed the Council of Latin American Studies at Duke University.
