

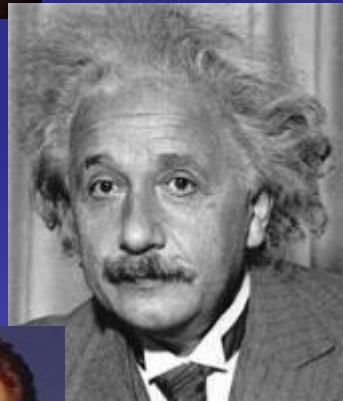

## Mobility is highly correlated with entrepreneurship

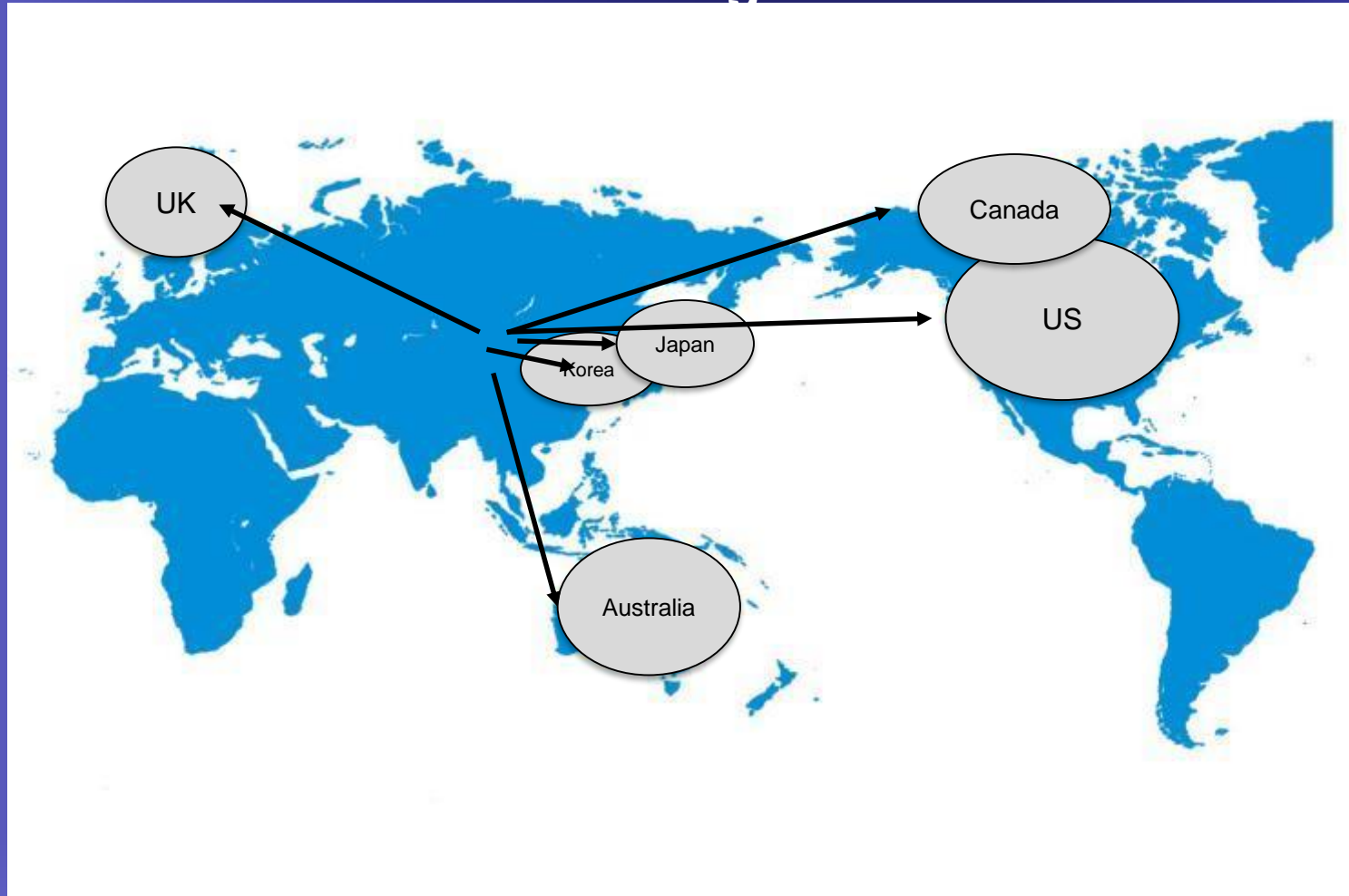


“Entrepreneurial activity amongst non-UK nationals was found to be ‘double the amount’ of British-born individuals”

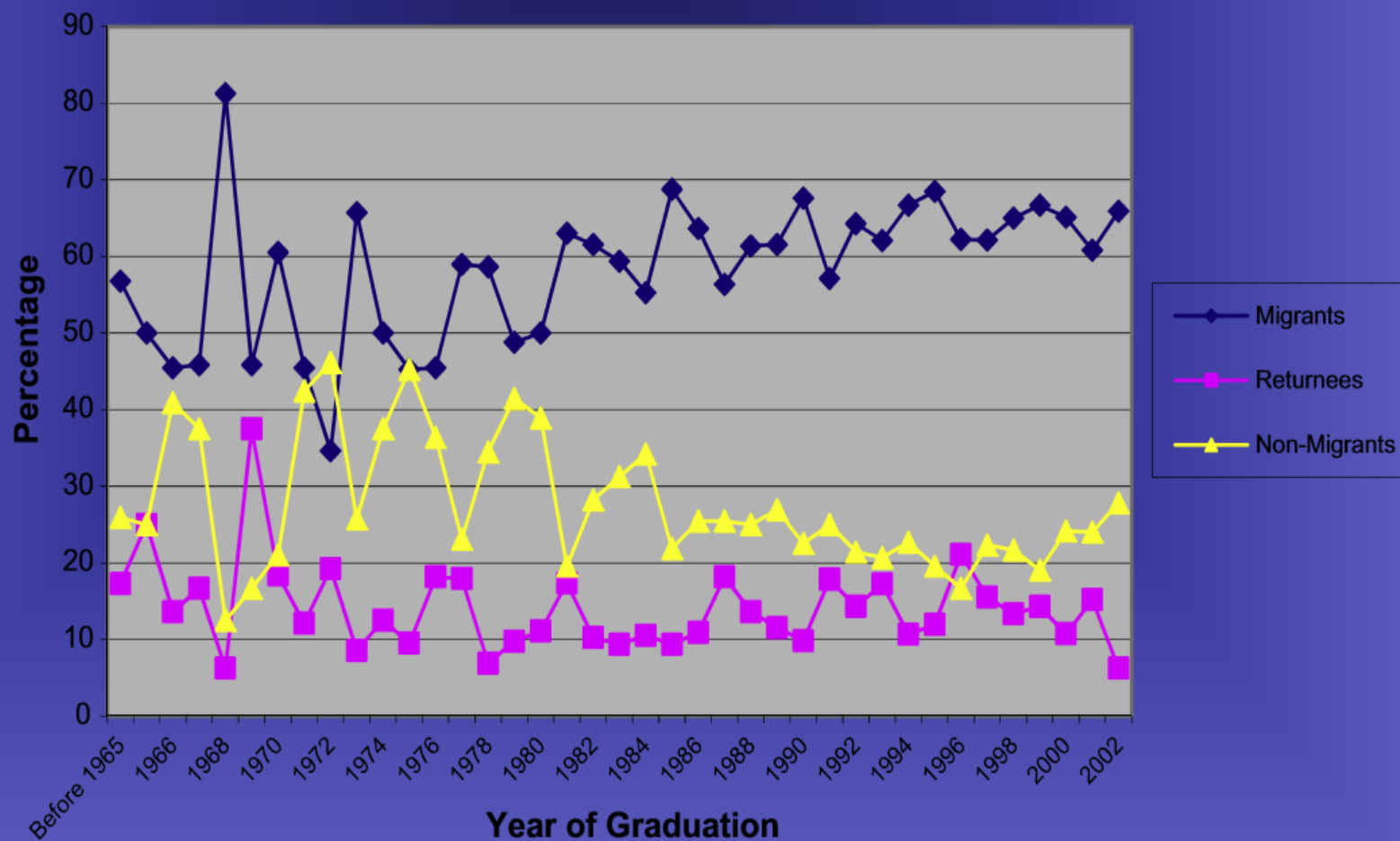


“The most entrepreneurial group in America wasn’t born in America. Immigrants now launch more than a quarter of U.S. Businesses.” (Bluestein, 2015)
