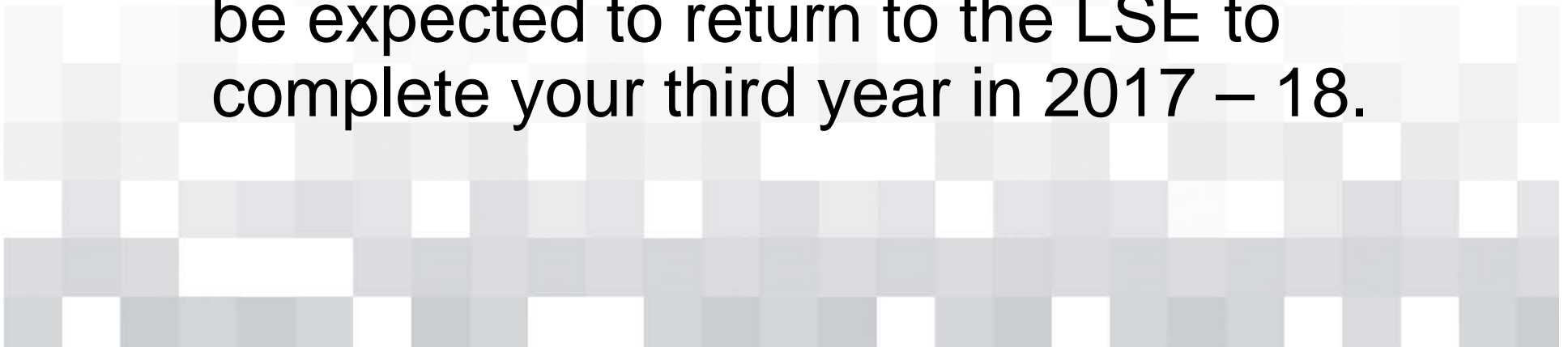

The Exchange



- 10 places for 2nd year, undergraduate students;
- You will spend an academic year at the University of California, Berkeley campus.
- The exchange is in addition towards the full length of your programme – you will be expected to return to the LSE to complete your third year in 2017 – 18.



Funding



You pay:

- Fees for Home / UK students: £1350 (to be confirmed)
- Fees for international students: Amount to be confirmed (£4500 in 2015)

You receive:

All students:

- LSE Exchange Bursary: £2500

Home UK students:

- LSE Bursary (if you receive this in UK, you will also receive for your year in the USA)

Home/EU students:

- LSE EU Bursary (if you receive this in UK, you will also receive for your year in USA)

Limited funding is available for students with widening participation needs.

How to apply



- Application cover sheet including details of first year modules and grades achieved
- Academic reference (from LSE academic staff member in your home department eg. your Academic Adviser or Departmental Tutor but not a Graduate Teaching Assistant)
- Personal statement of up to **1250 words** showing:
 - Your educational journey so far.
 - The reasons you would like to take part in the University of California, Berkeley exchange.
 - How does the exchange at University of California, Berkeley relate to your degree programme at LSE?
 - Your ambitions beyond your LSE degree.

When to apply



Application deadline:

12pm (noon) on Monday 29th February 2016

(successful applications informed by end of term)

E-mail Erasmus@lse.ac.uk with 'University of Berkeley application' as the subject and attach:

- Application cover sheet
- Personal statement
- Academic reference (reference can be sent by your adviser directly to Erasmus – ensure your name is clear on the reference)

After you apply



- We plan to inform successful applicants of the outcome by the end of Lent Term.
- We will email all applicants with the outcome – we are unable to provide individual feedback on applications.
- You will need to complete Berkeley's application process including ensuring you have the right pre-requisites, creating a study plan and have the requirements to be sponsored for a visa.
- You will be required to complete paperwork to receive your bursary from LSE.
- More detailed advice will be given to successful applicants.
