

What does 'accessible online documents' mean?

Accessible online documents can be read by all users, including those who have disabilities or impairments affecting reading or the use of a computer, or those who use assistive technology to access online information. Accessible online material benefits all students.

It is a requirement under equality legislation to ensure that online teaching materials are accessible so that no student is excluded because of a disability. Making information accessible online is not more expensive or more complicated. It only requires some awareness and probably a shift in your production process, and getting used to it. Accessible documents are easier to maintain, update and convert into other formats
