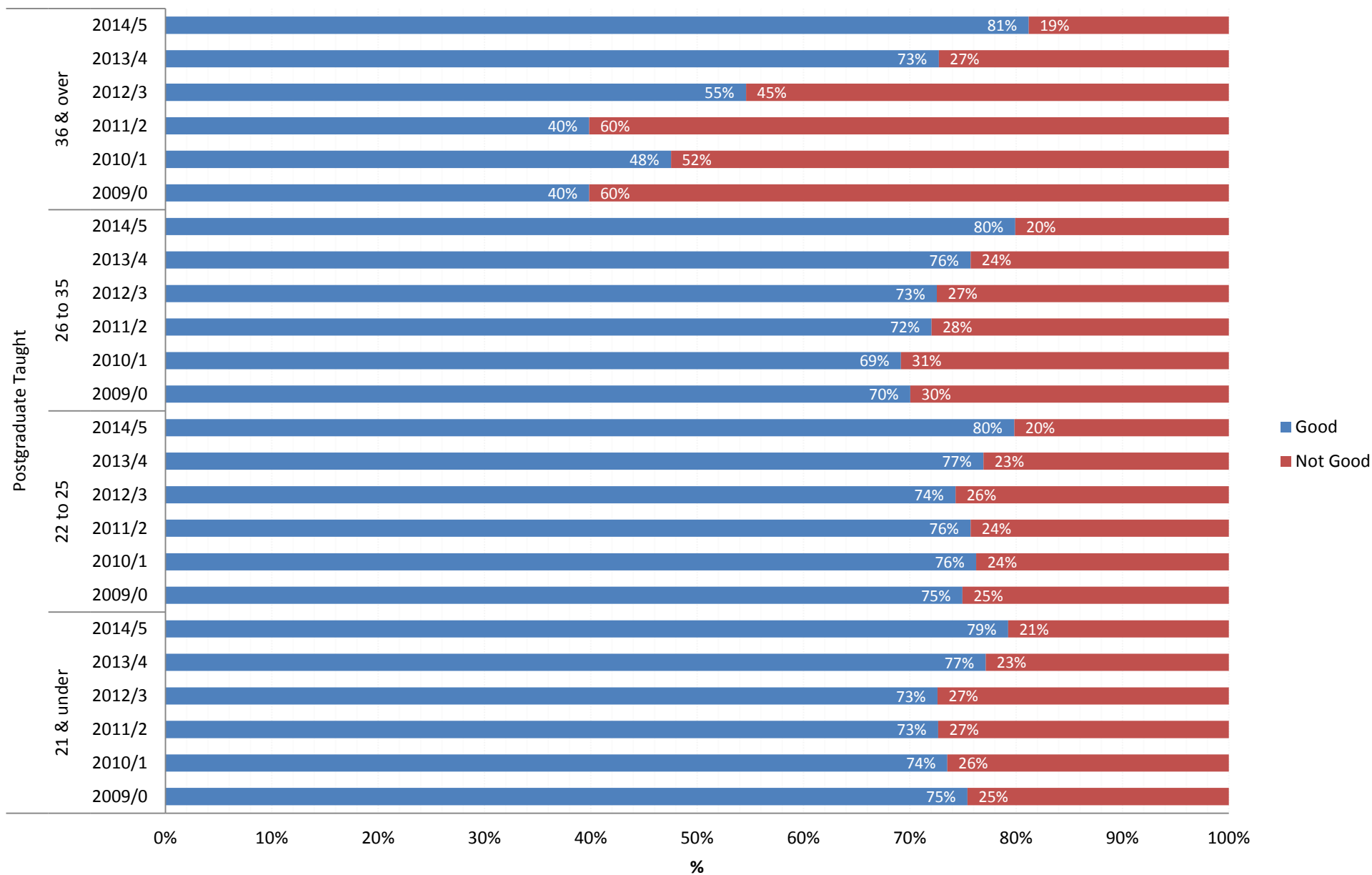
Non-UK domiciles are shown as a whole, but not in detail, in both graphs and tables.

The population for other characteristics (Age, Disability & Gender) is for all students, regardless of Domicile.

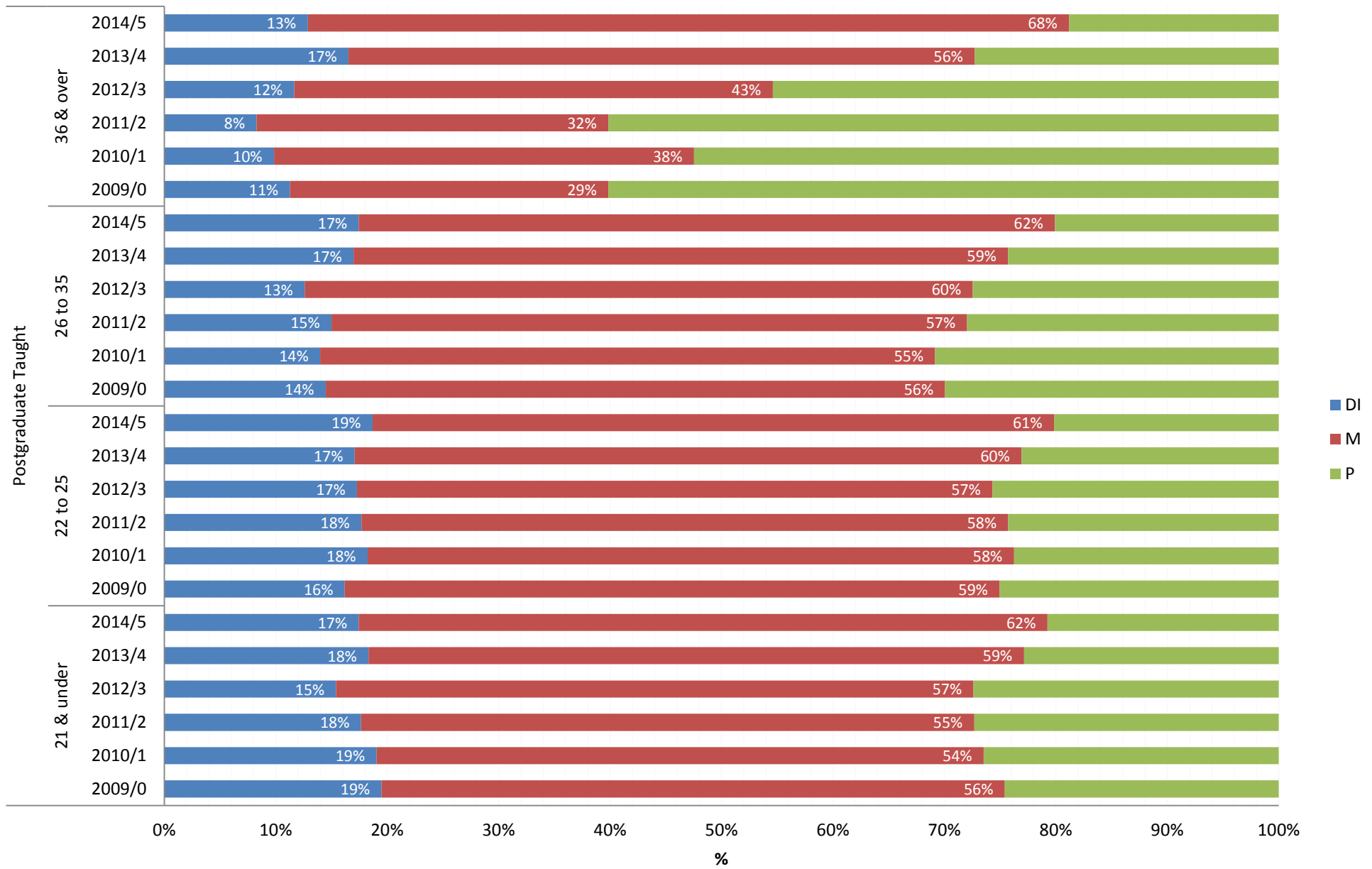

## Age on Entry, Classifications

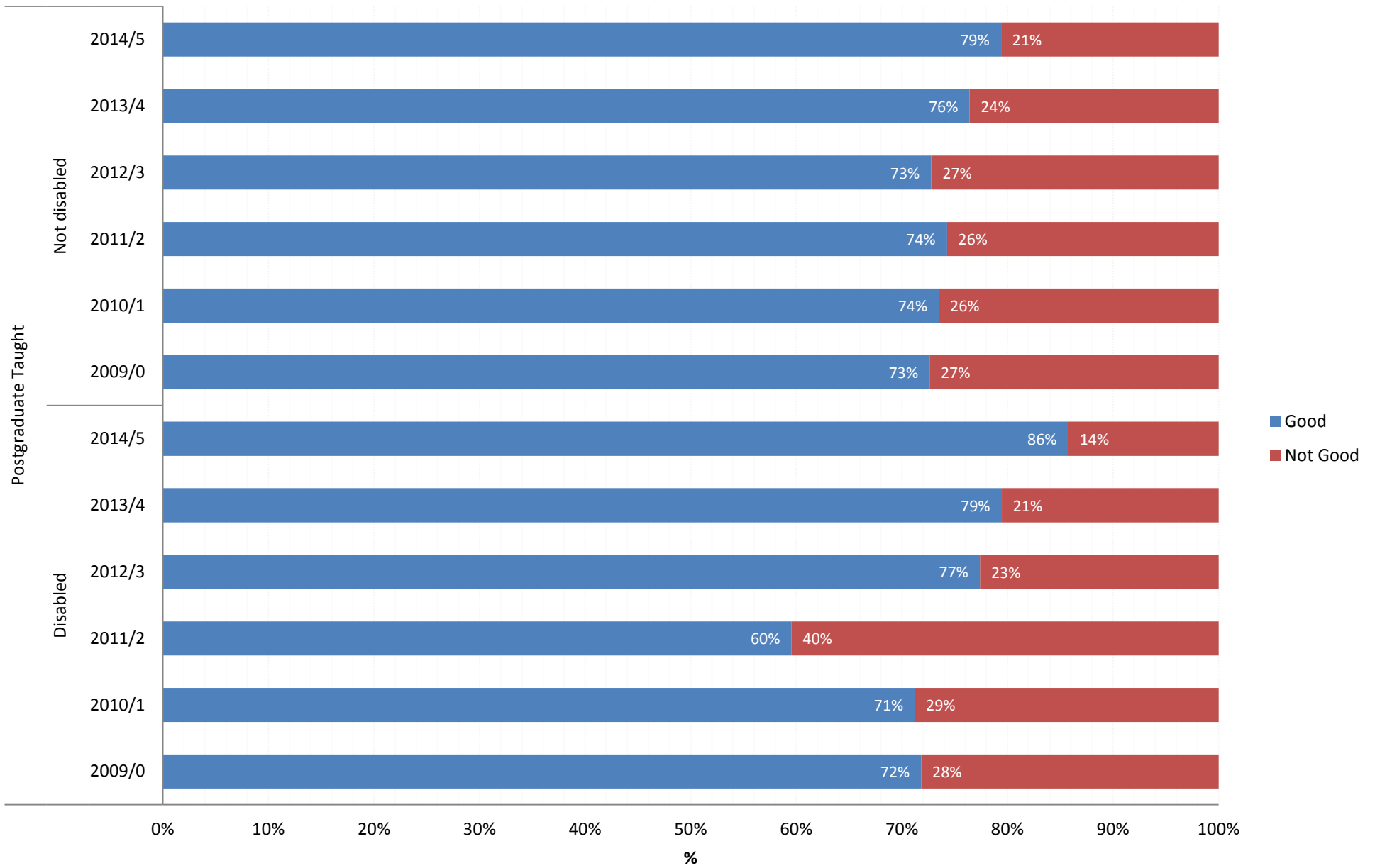

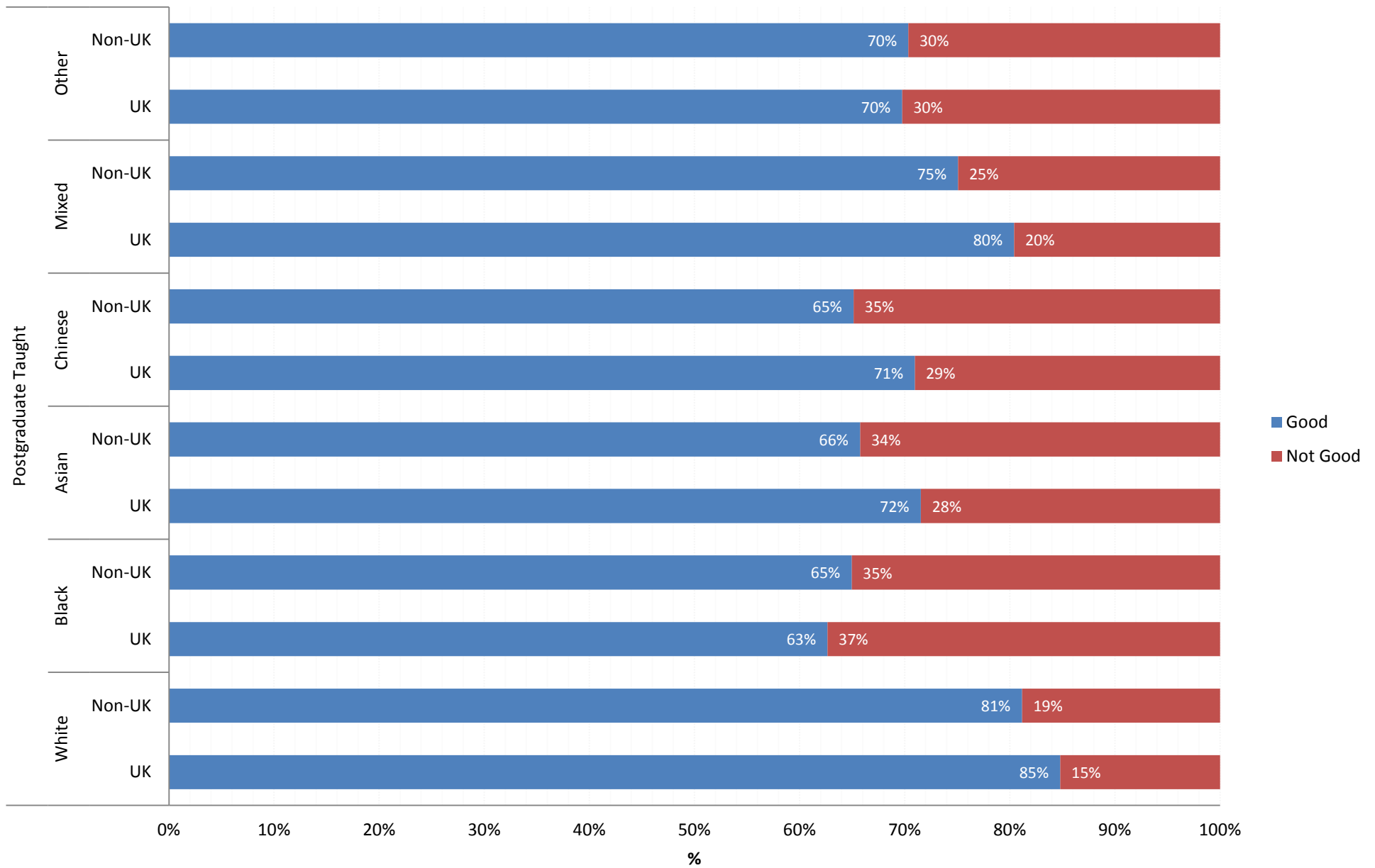

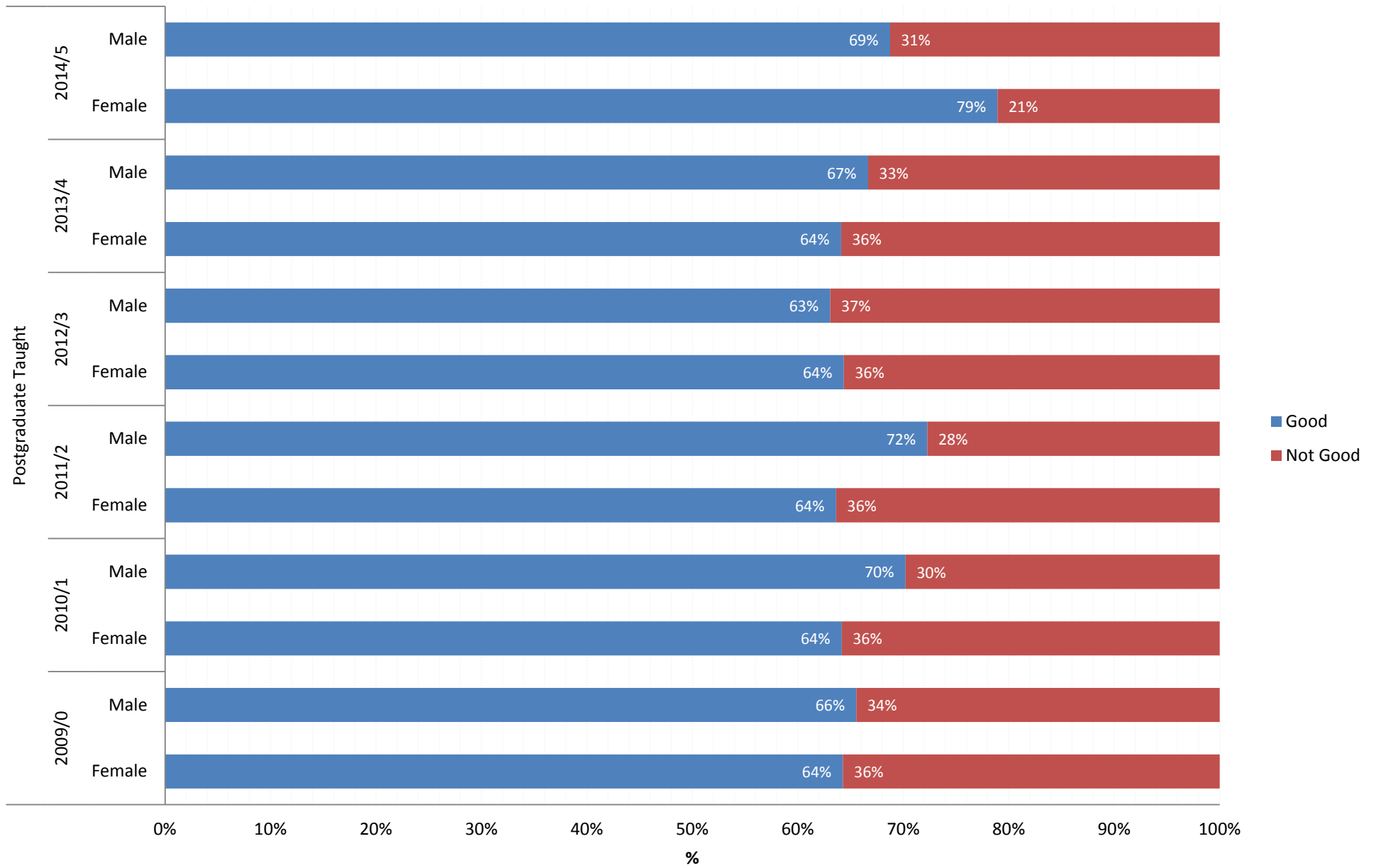
