Progression defined as:

2. Successful completion of degree programme.

Non-Progression defined broadly as:

1. Those not progressing to the next year of study on their degree programme, or
2. Those who withdraw, required to take summer resits or go before the Student Progression Panel (SPP) to get permission to progress while carrying courses to resit.

* Ethnicity is shown in detail for UK-domiciled students only.

This aligns with the Equality Challenge Unit (ECU) treatment of national data, reporting on UK-domiciled student only. The ECU's treatment is based on Ethnicity only being mandatory to report for UK-domiciled students.

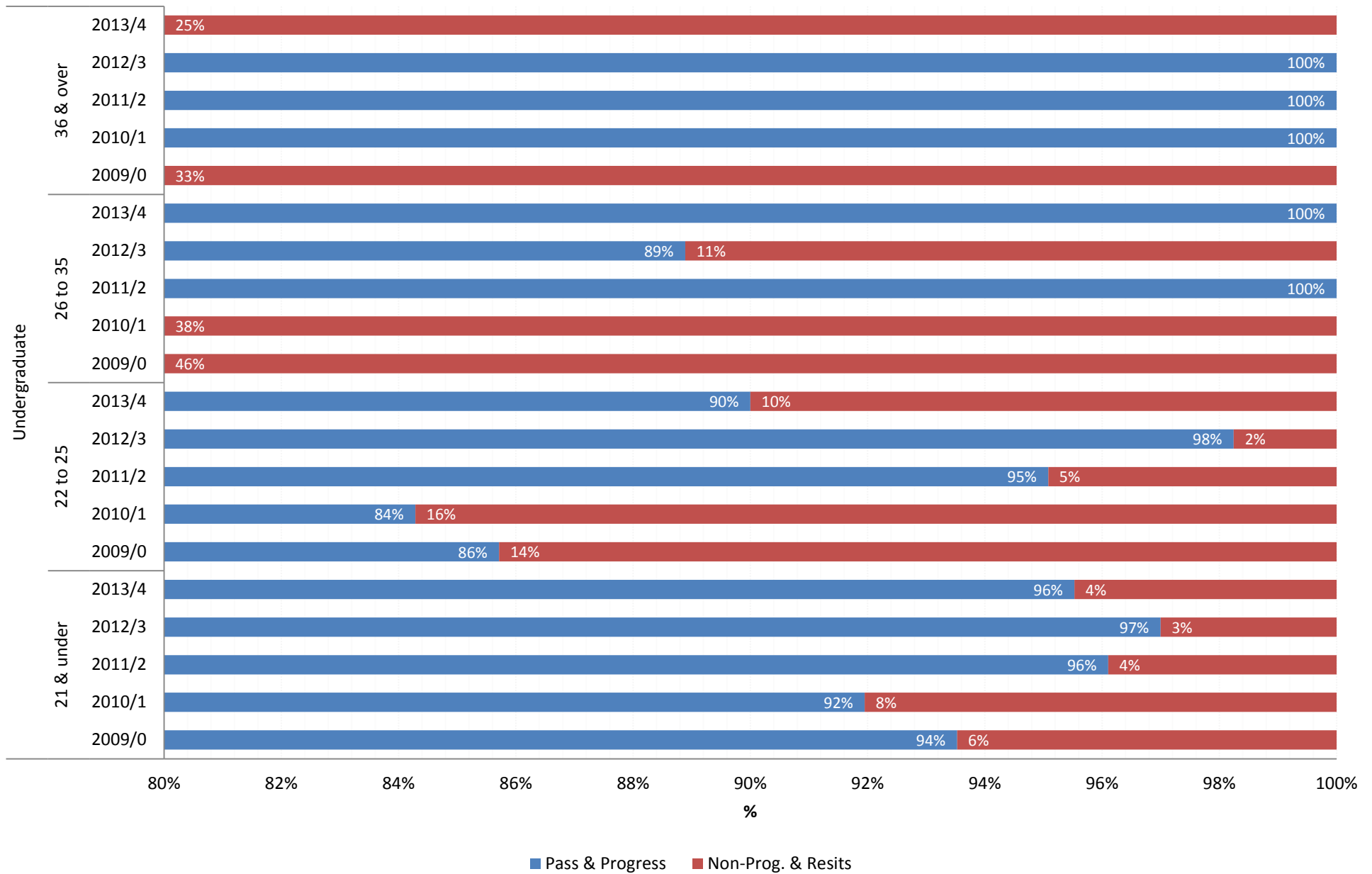
Non-UK domiciles are shown as a whole, but not in detail, in both graphs and tables.

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Age on Entry, Progression

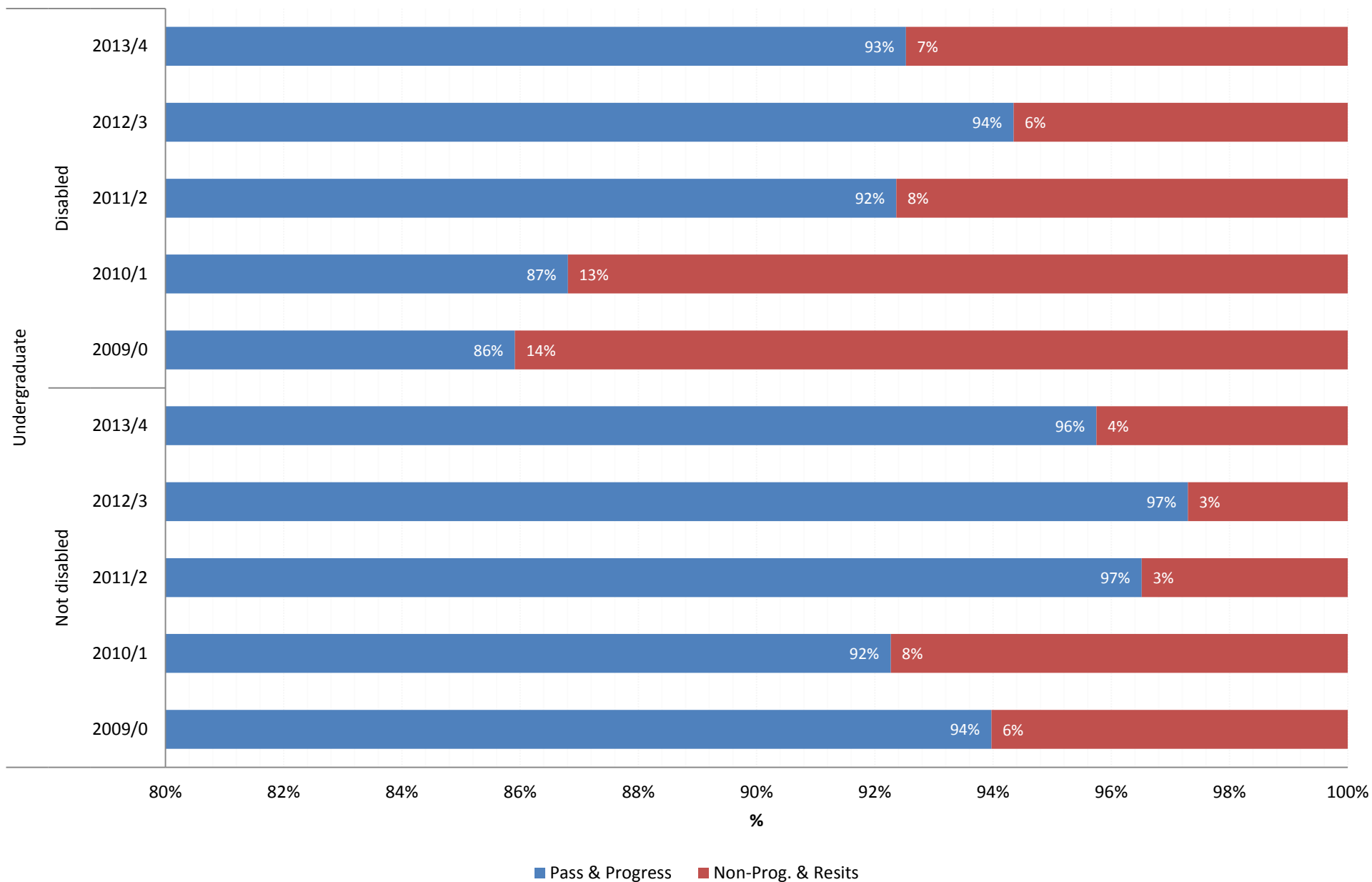

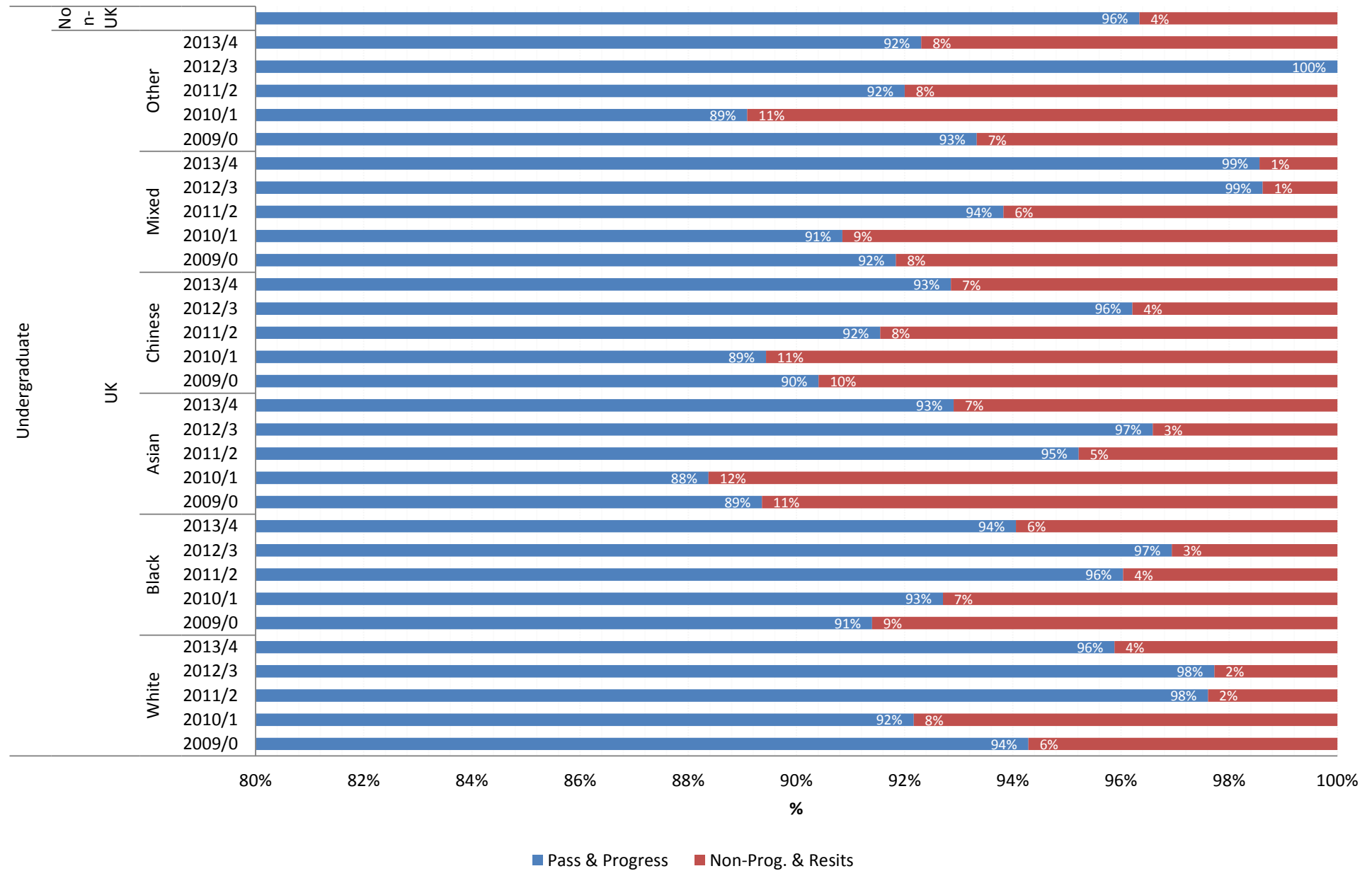

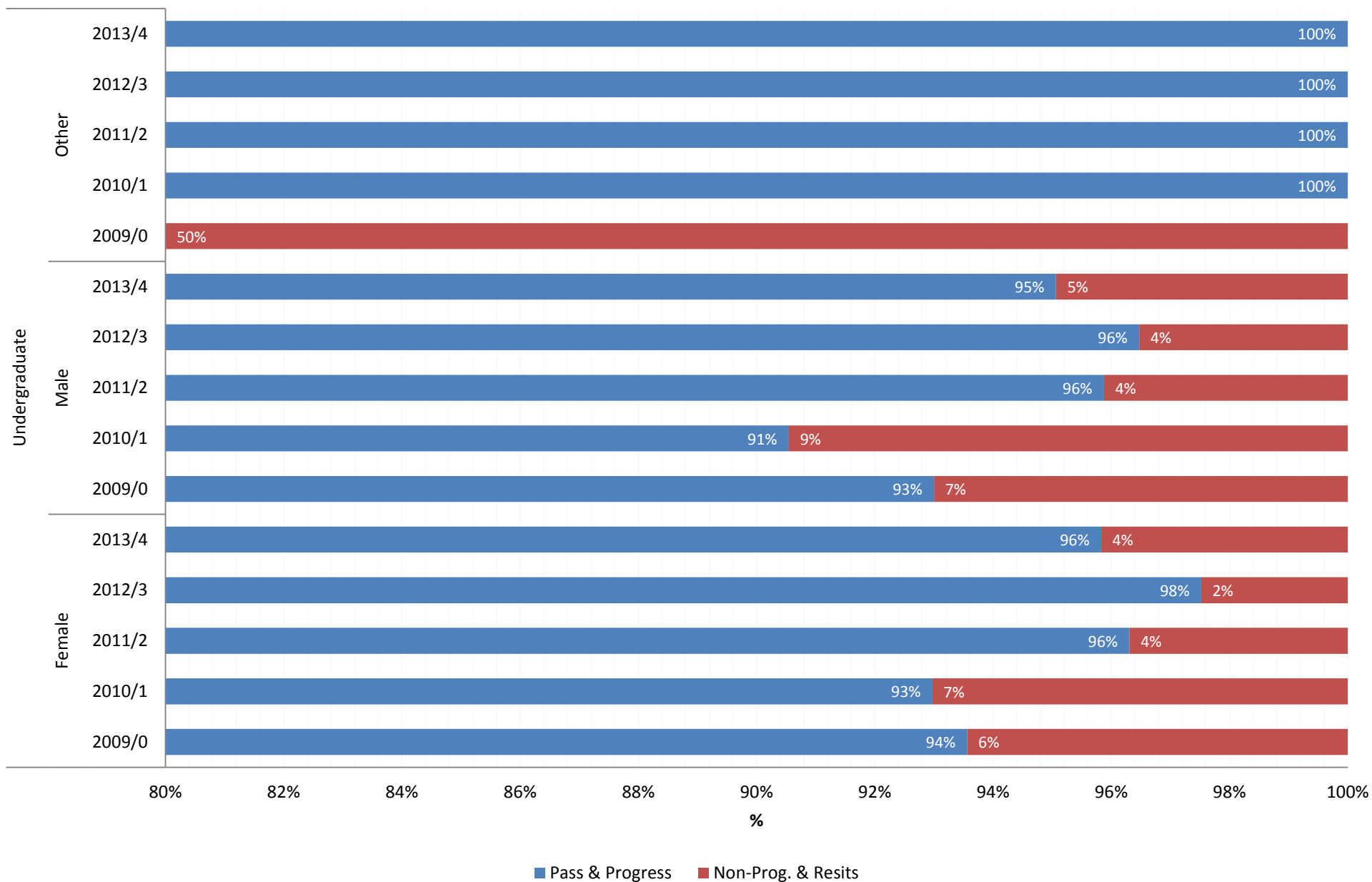
