Introduction

The Estates Division once again had an extremely busy summer period. Following on from our newsletter in June of this year, we completed a wide range of projects. Projects range from some you don't see at all such as improvement works to gas and water meters to much more visible progress on the Saw Swee Hock Centre, which approaches completion with occupation planned for the New Year.

To meet the requirements of the School's summer recruitment programme, we have refurbished 75 separate offices across the campus for 17 different departments and completed a major refurbishment of parts of the ground and first floors of Sardinia House. Many new staff were successfully accommodated in time for the new academic year.
