

Saw Swee Hock Student Centre

The Saw Swee Hock Student Centre is a new purpose-built centre to accommodate student services, enhancing the LSE student experience by providing world-class facilities. It opened for use in January 2014. It meets the highest environmental standards, and achieved BREEAM “Outstanding” status by:

- Improving biodiversity
 - A green roof, native plant species planters, a bat box and a bird box are featured on the 5th floor.
- Increasing water efficiency:
 - Rainwater and greywater is collected to feed WCs and plant equipment, reducing mains water consumption.
 - Low flush WCs save water.
- Increasing energy efficiency:
 - Combined Heat and Power unit and solar PV arrays generate electricity for use on campus.
 - Automated sub-meters for electricity and gas will provide highly localised consumption information for effective monitoring.
