



Senior Common Room

As a member of staff, you are invited to become a member of the Senior Common Room, which plays a central role in the academic and social life of the School.

Membership gives you access to all the Common Room facilities, including the Staff Dining Room, located on the fifth floor of the Old Building, and, next door, the Senior Common Room itself, where a large number of newspapers and periodicals are available.

The Senior Common Room hosts two major social events a year, which both take place in the Summer Term. The first is the Strawberry Tea and the second, to which a guest speaker is invited, is the Senior Common Room Dinner. Members are sent notices of these events at the appropriate times.

*The salary ranges shown correlate with points on the School's salary scales and are adjusted in line with pay awards. Part-time staff pay the subscription appropriate to their pro-rated salary.
