- Continental Europe’s largest Humanities and Social Sciences library



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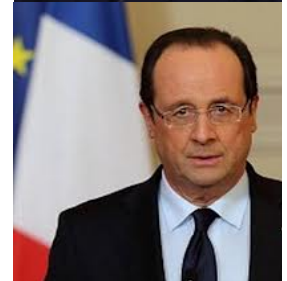
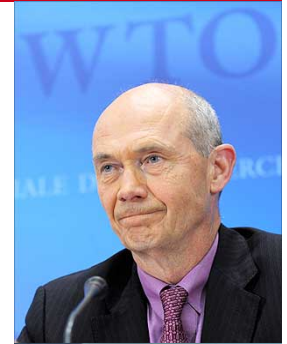

- English, French, Chinese, Japanese, Hindi and Korean



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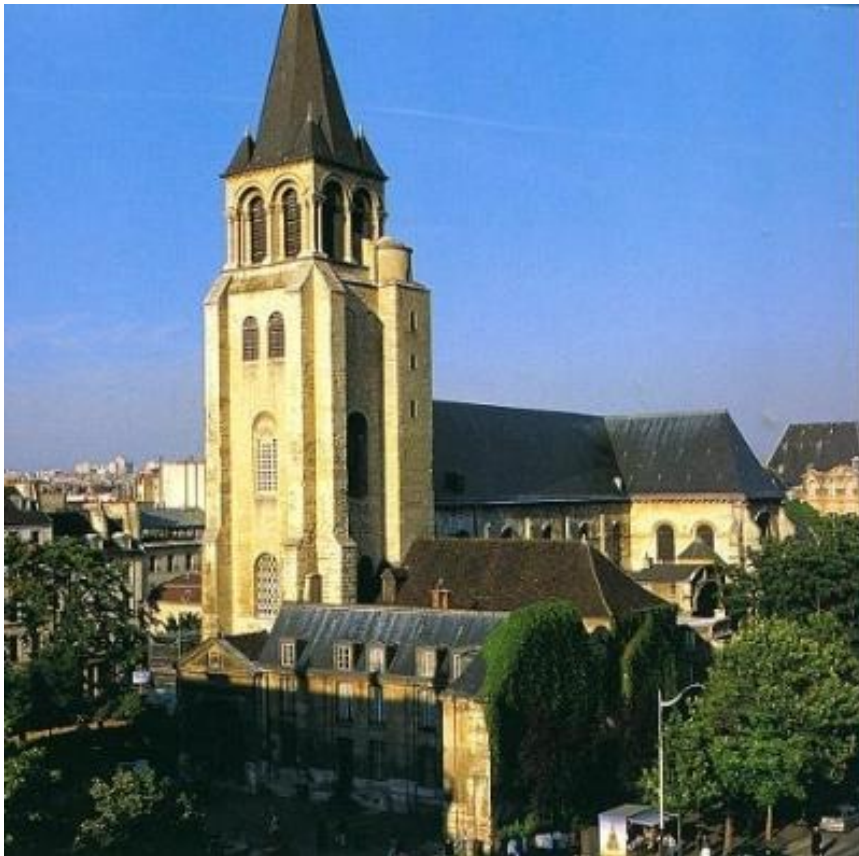
Euro-American campus Reims

- English and French





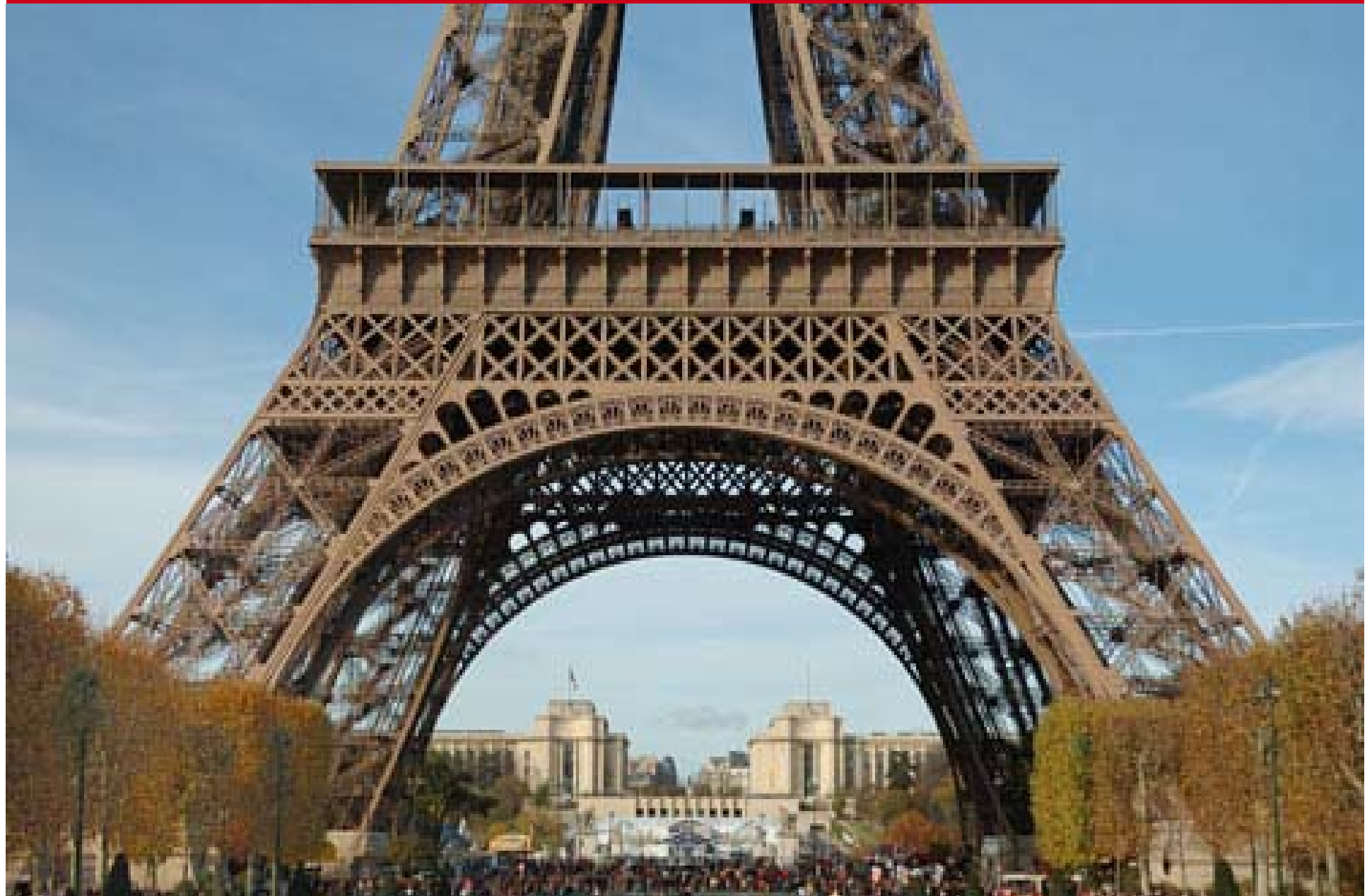
General programme Paris

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Financial issues

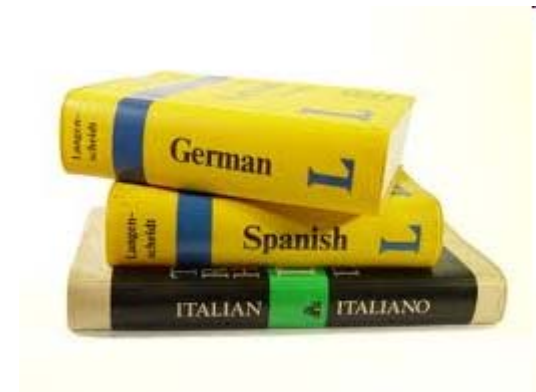
- Sciences Po will not charge you

- Nancy: English, German and Basic French
- Poitiers: English and Spanish or Portuguese
