The winner of this category was joint nominees Geoffrey Osborne, O'Donnell + Tuomey Projects and Foundation Developments for the LSE Saw Swee Hock Student Centre, London. This was awarded for a multi-functional student hub spread over nine floors on a confined footprint in the centre of London. Judges said the varied and exceptional concrete finishes "may divide opinions but this iconic structure is architecturally impressive".
