PROJECT AND PROGRAMME

Substructure and basement works are progressing, with the final phase of piling ongoing. This piling includes the formation of a temporary contiguous piled wall, which will surround a grey water harvesting tank. Concrete pours of the basement slab and lining walls are a daily occurrence, which are bringing the works closer to the completion of the substructure.

We again thank you for your patience with the amount of vehicle movement to and from site during this busy period. Every effort is being put in by the site team to ensure that there is minimal disruption to the students and surrounding neighbours.
