



SIDNEY WEBB HOUSE RULES

Sidney Webb House is your home. Guests are welcome but must be signed-in (two per person) .

Initiate contact with the duty subwarden if you experience a personal problem or are worried about a fellow resident.

Disciplinary rules of the LSE apply in Sidney Webb House to ensure the safety and wellbeing of residents. Identify yourself to a member of CRM or LSE staff when asked.

No smoking anywhere in the building. Smoking is only permitted in the designated smoking area outside the building.

Ensure that you leave the Atlas and other common areas in a clean and tidy state after use.

Your home is a workplace for others. Treat members of staff with due respect.

Work with members of staff to keep Sidney Webb safe. Keep fire doors closed, report any suspected security issues and do not let strangers into the building.

Ensure that you report maintenance problems in the building to reception.

Be quiet in the Courtyard. Your License Agreement states that there should be no noise after 11pm.

Be aware that the fire alarm can go off at any time day or night. Evacuate the building immediately when you hear the arm.
