Notes

BA / BSc:

- i) For students who commenced their BA/BSc programme before 2007/8, the pass mark was 34.
- ii) Before 1989/90 no module grades or marks were published for BSc Economics.

LLB:

- iii) Before 1994/5, LLB modules were marked out of 200, not 100, marks eg a mark of 140 would now be equivalent to one of 70.
- iv) For Intermediate Level papers only a grade of 'Pass' or 'Fail' is awarded.

Diploma:

- v) Before 2007/8 only a grade of 'Pass' or 'Fail' was awarded. The pass mark was 40.

Masters:

- vi) Before 1997/8 no module grades or marks are shown for any Masters programme
- vii) The grade of 'Distinction' was introduced in 1998/9 and that of 'Merit' from 1999/2000, although these grades were not awarded on some programmes of study until subsequent academic years.
- viii) Before 2002/3 the pass mark for some modules was 40%.
- ix) Before 2003/4 no module grades or marks are shown for the LLM.
- x) Before 2005/6 no module grades or marks are shown for the MSc Philosophy and History of Science.
