The Chilean artist, Ingrid Wildi, records in this video-essay the search for her missing mother, a well-known clairvoyant who helps the police with difficult cases. Contrasting with the mother's foresight, the artist's video-insight works throughout the film to disclose the narratives of the past of the family and of Chile. Wildi, whose work moves in the space between documentary film and art film, questions her grandmother, an art critic, an uncle who is an anaesthetist and an aunt. The artist travels from Santiago to Arica in this complex search for reality.
