

Waiting List 2016/17 Applications

How do you process applications placed on the waiting list?

We make offers to anyone placed on the waiting list as and when rooms become available.

Using our waiting list, we make offers of accommodation to graduates for the academic year 2016/17 from **31 July 2016**.

We have certain priorities when dealing with the waiting list to determine who is made an offer first. We will process all applications in a priority group before moving on to the next.

The following is our list of priorities from highest to lowest.

First priority - New undergraduates and General Course students

Those who have not been made an accommodation offer by LSE before for the academic year 2016/17 will be made offers first.

We then move on to consider other applications for decisions.

Second priority - New graduates

Those who hold an unconditional and accepted course offer and those who have not been made an accommodation offer by LSE before for the academic year 2016/17 will be made offers first.

We then move on to consider other applications for decisions.

Third priority - Returning undergraduates

If you are a returning undergraduate, you will not receive an offer of accommodation via the waiting list until after 20 August 2016.

Fourth priority - All others

We will then consider all other applications made to our waiting list.
