


## I. OPPORTUNITIES

*Distribution of children according to different types of users*




## II. RISK & HARM

*Distribution of children according to different types of risk & harm*



## IV. OVERALL CLASSIFICATION



**AUSTRIA** belongs to the “Unprotected networkers” group of countries

This cluster stands out for having the highest percentage of young networkers and all-round explorers, while restricted learners are underrepresented compared to the average. The risk pattern of the countries in this cluster is close to the average, with a slightly higher number of children in the contact risks group. This cluster has the lowest percentage of children in the all-round mediation group (13%), while most belong to the passive mediation group (37%). Although Lithuania is geographically further away, Austria, Hungary and Slovenia form a special Central European cluster with children from groups that can be described as high on network opportunities and related risks while having parents with more passive mediation strategies.
