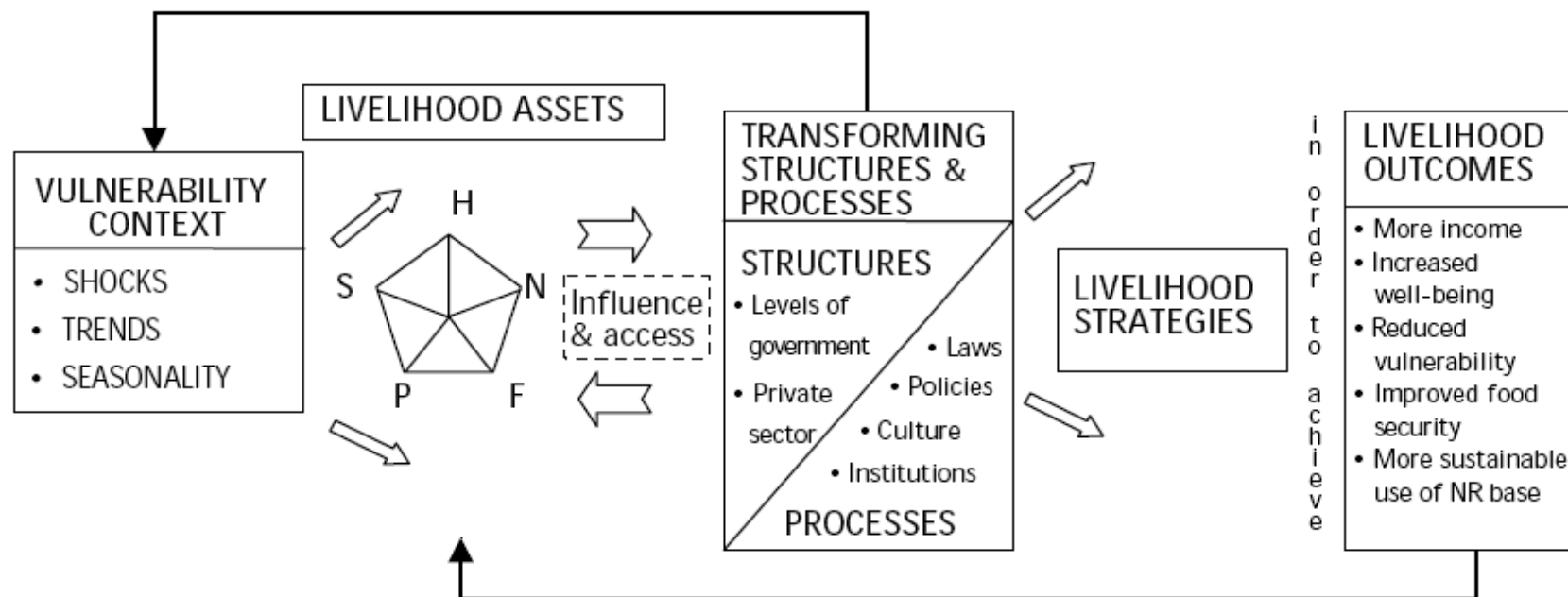

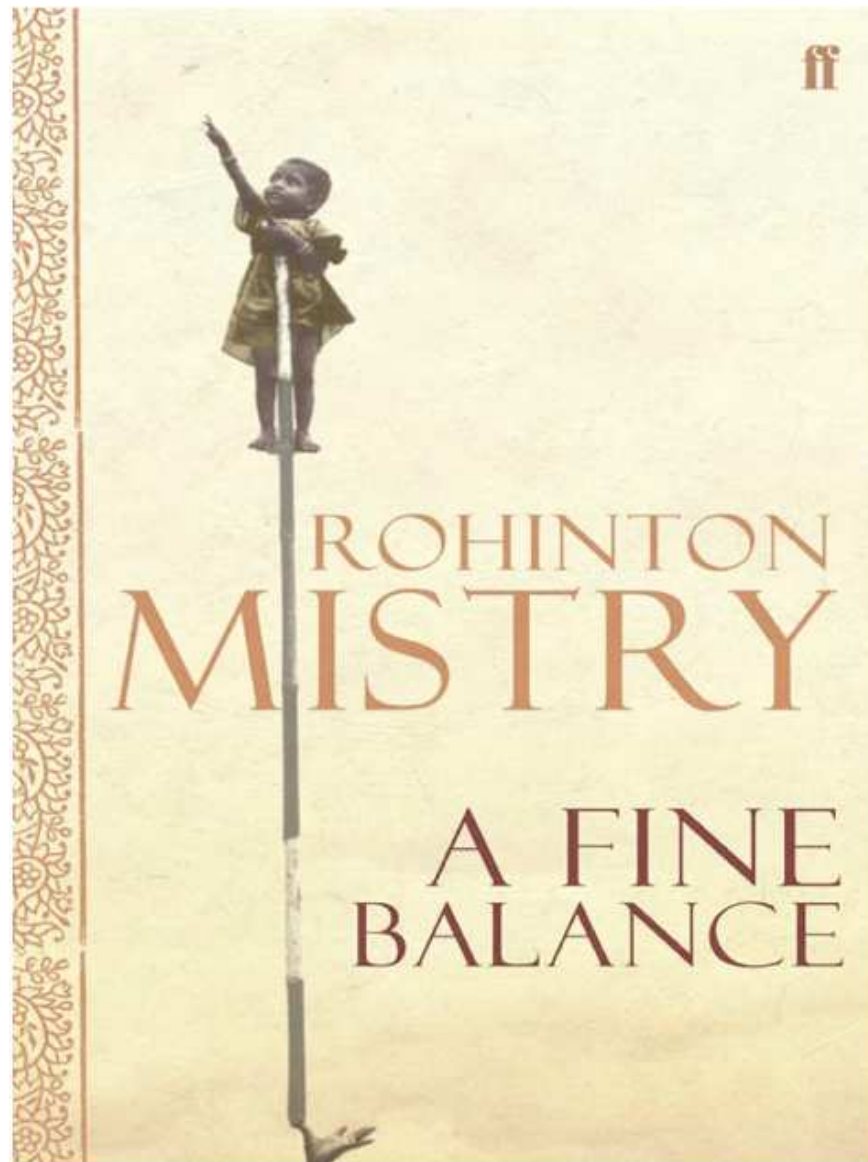


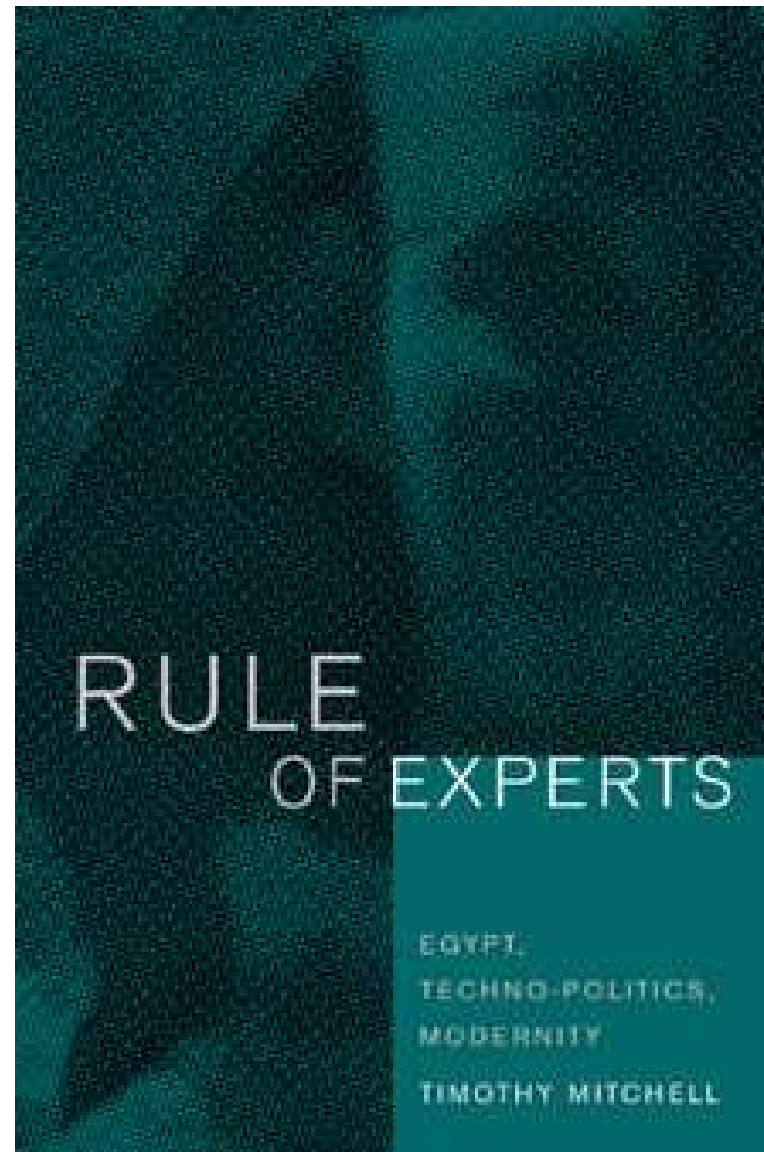
Figure 1. Sustainable livelihoods framework

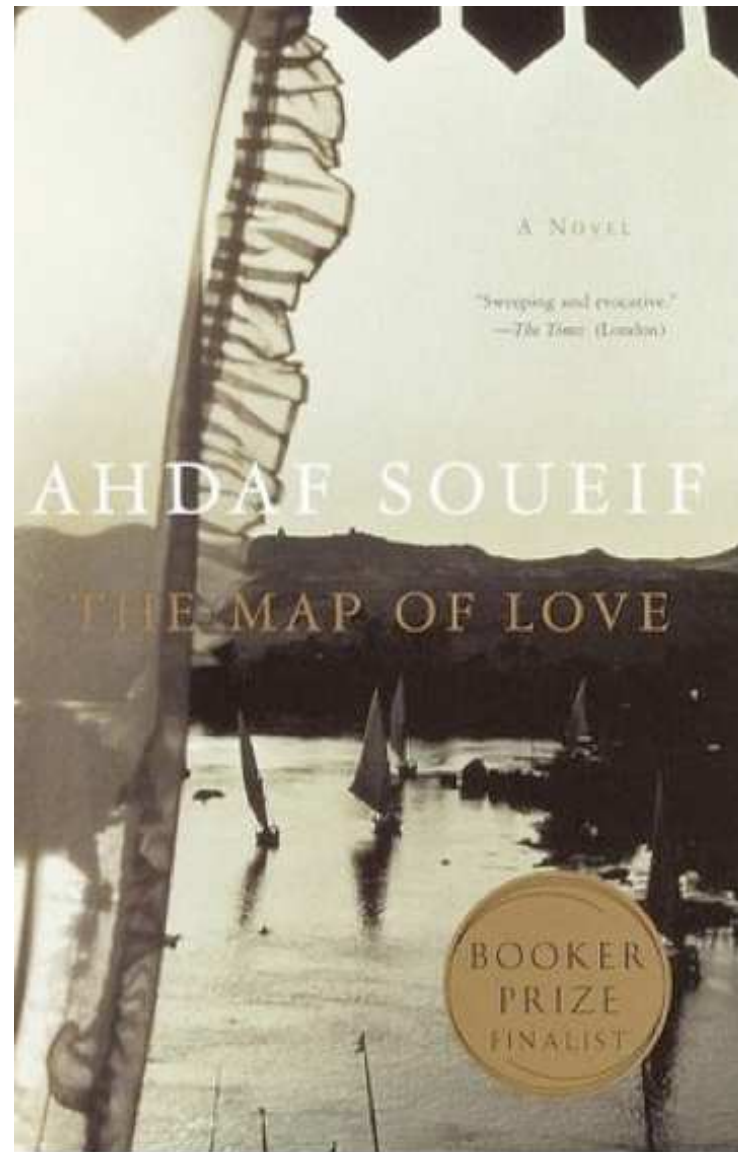
Key

 F = Financial Capital







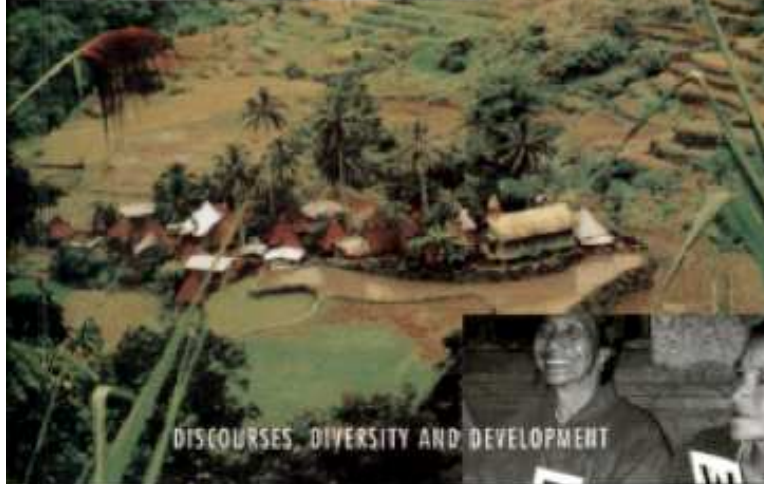

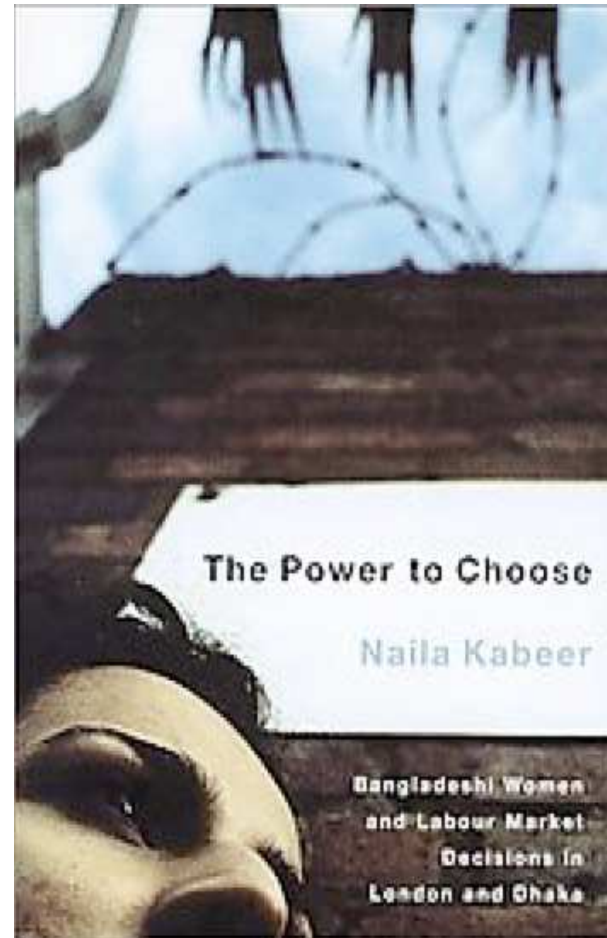
