Much of Professor Laird's research has focused on energy policy, particularly the way that renewable energy policies interact with environmental policy. His book *Solar Energy, Technology Policy, and Institutional Values* (Cambridge University Press 2001) looked at the ways in which institutionally embedded ideas shaped energy policy over a 35 year period. He is currently working on a project funded by the National Science Foundation comparing US and German renewable energy policy and on a second project relating innovation policy to energy policy. In addition to energy policy, he has also published in the areas of climate change policy, environmental policy, democratic theory and S&T policy, and institutions and S&T policy.
