THEMES

Taking place in the heart of London, this unique conference will bring together academics and policy-makers from a wide range of disciplines to take a multidisciplinary approach to key health and social care issues.

Sessions will cover five conference themes with disciplines from health economics, political science and law to epidemiology, demography and sociology all expected to be represented.

- **International health systems:** health systems financing; international health reforms; global health and sustainable development; performance measurement; health inequalities.
- **Social care and mental health:** economic aspects of community care; residential and nursing home provision; long-term care finance; mental health policy.
- **Regulation and assessment of health technologies:** assessment of pharmaceuticals and medical devices; substantiality of health care financing; economic access to health technologies; pharmaceutical policy.
- **Behaviour:** understanding and changing behaviour at the individual and population level; role of behavioural insights in public policy making.
- **Population Studies:** aging; life course, socioeconomic and intergenerational influences on individual and population health.
