## Financial Support



Your first point of contact should be your home government, ministry of education, or nearest British Council office for information and advice about financial aid and scholarships for overseas study. You may also find information on the Study UK [website](#) useful.

You should bear in mind that securing financial aid can be a fairly long process, so we advise you to start your research and application(s) as soon as possible.

## LSE Undergraduate Support Scheme

The LSE Undergraduate Support Scheme is designed to help international students who do not have the necessary funds to meet all of their costs.

Applications can be downloaded from the Fees and Funding [website](#). If you are eligible to be entered for any LSE Scholarships then the Financial Support office will use the same information to put you forward for those – you will not need to complete a second form. You are advised to apply early. The deadline for completed application forms is the **26 April 2018**.

For 2018, the overseas scholarships include the LSE Mauritius Scholarship, which has a value of the School's fee £19,152 in 2018-19 per annum.
