# The Exchange



- 10 places for 2<sup>nd</sup> year, undergraduate students;
- You will spend an academic year at one of the Sciences Po campuses:
  - Paris
  - Dijon
  - Le Havre
  - Menton
  - Nancy
  - Poitiers
  - Reims
- The exchange is in addition towards the full length of your programme – you will be expected to return to the LSE to complete your third year in 2017 – 18.

# Funding



## **You pay:**

- Fees for Home / UK students: £1350 (to be confirmed)
- Fees for international students: Amount to be confirmed (£4500 in 2015)

## **You receive:**

### **All students:**

- LSE Exchange Bursary: £2500
- Erasmus Mobility Grant €300 per month in 2015/2016 but likely to be less in 2016/2017

### **Home UK students:**

- LSE Bursary (if you receive this in UK, you will also receive for your year in France)

### **Home/EU students:**

- LSE EU Bursary (if you receive this in UK, you will also receive for your year in France)

**Additional Erasmus funding is available for those with recognised Widening Participation needs or Special Needs.**

# How to apply



- Application cover sheet including details of first year modules and grades achieved
- Academic reference (from LSE academic staff member in your home department eg. your Academic Adviser or Departmental Tutor but not a Graduate Teaching Assistant)
- Personal statement of up to **1250 words** showing:
  - Your educational journey so far.
  - The reasons you would like to take part in the Sciences Po exchange.
  - Which campus you would like to study at and why?
  - How does the exchange at Sciences Po relate to your degree programme at LSE?
  - What languages might you want to study during the exchange?
  - Your ambitions beyond your LSE degree.

# When to apply



## Application deadline:

**12pm (noon) on Monday 29<sup>th</sup> February 2016**

(successful applications informed by end of term)

E-mail [Erasmus@lse.ac.uk](mailto:Erasmus@lse.ac.uk) with 'Sciences Po application' as the subject and attach:

- Application cover sheet
- Personal statement
- Academic reference (reference can be sent by your adviser directly to Erasmus – ensure your name is clear on the reference)

# After you apply



- We plan to inform successful applicants of the outcome by the end of Lent Term.
- We will email all applicants with the outcome – we are unable to provide individual feedback on applications.
- We will nominate you to Sciences Po and you will be required to complete their application process.
- You will be required to complete paperwork to receive your Sciences Po bursary and Erasmus Grant.
- More detailed advice will be given to successful applicants.
