International Financial Markets Study Tour

This one-week annual programme, for Instituto de Estudios Bursátiles students approaching the end of their Masters degree, has run since 2006. It has been designed to deliver a combination of current marketplace practice and the latest academic teaching in the areas of financial markets, including in-depth analysis of subjects such as evaluation, risk management and quantitative risk techniques.

The programme addresses how traditional financial skills, such as security valuation, are evolving to meet the new trading and economic environment. It exposes participants to several City institutions to give them practical views on financial market activity. It finishes with a look at the development of emerging financial markets in the future through the changing and integrating nature of regulation and its attempt to govern global financial markets.
