## Finding accommodation

Choosing the place you will call home during your studies is an important decision. LSE guarantees a place in halls of residence for all undergraduate offer holders, provided they apply before our deadline of 30 June 2016.

London is a fantastic city to live in, with attractions for everyone – be it live music, shopping, museums, or sports. There are a [variety of halls](#) available to you, and all are located close to the LSE campus and within walking distance.

LSE Accommodation offers shared or private rooms, and catered or self-catered living. There are also 31, 38, 40 or 50 week contracts available – depending on whether you wish to stay over the Christmas and Easter vacation periods.

If you prefer an active involvement in your accommodation, you can make a difference to the running of your halls by volunteering for one of the many roles that support social events, green issues, or peer support.

The online application process is now open. Applications are submitted through [Hallpad](#), LSE's online service which allows you to apply, track and manage your accommodation application.

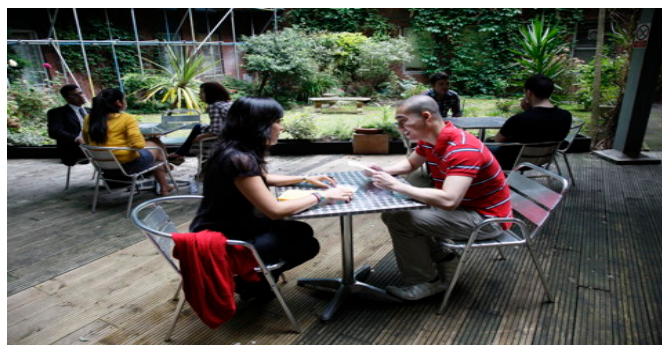
