Pre-Conference Social Event (Thursday, September 3, 18:00)

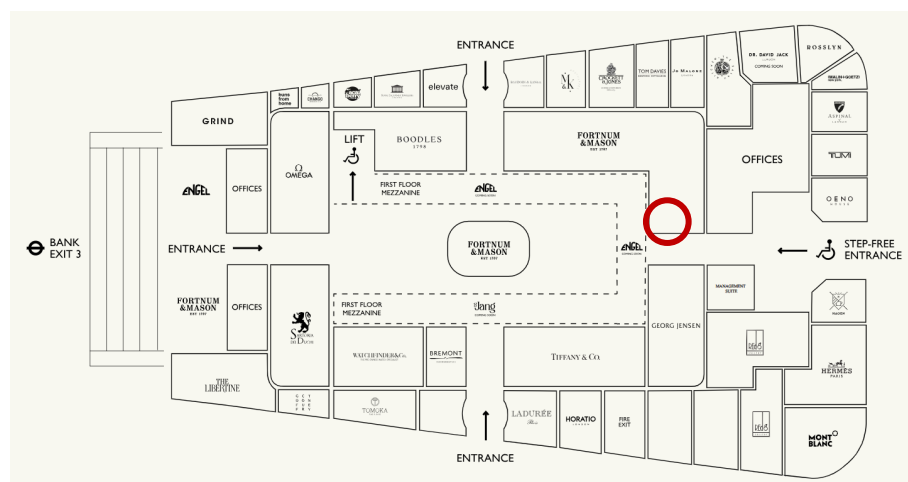
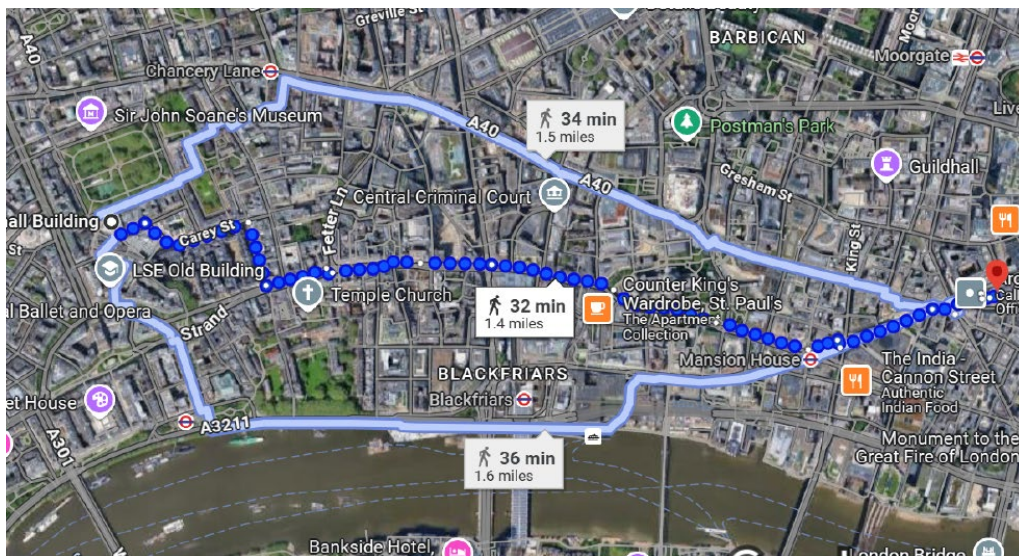
The Engel Bar is located on the mezzanine level of the Royal Exchange.
