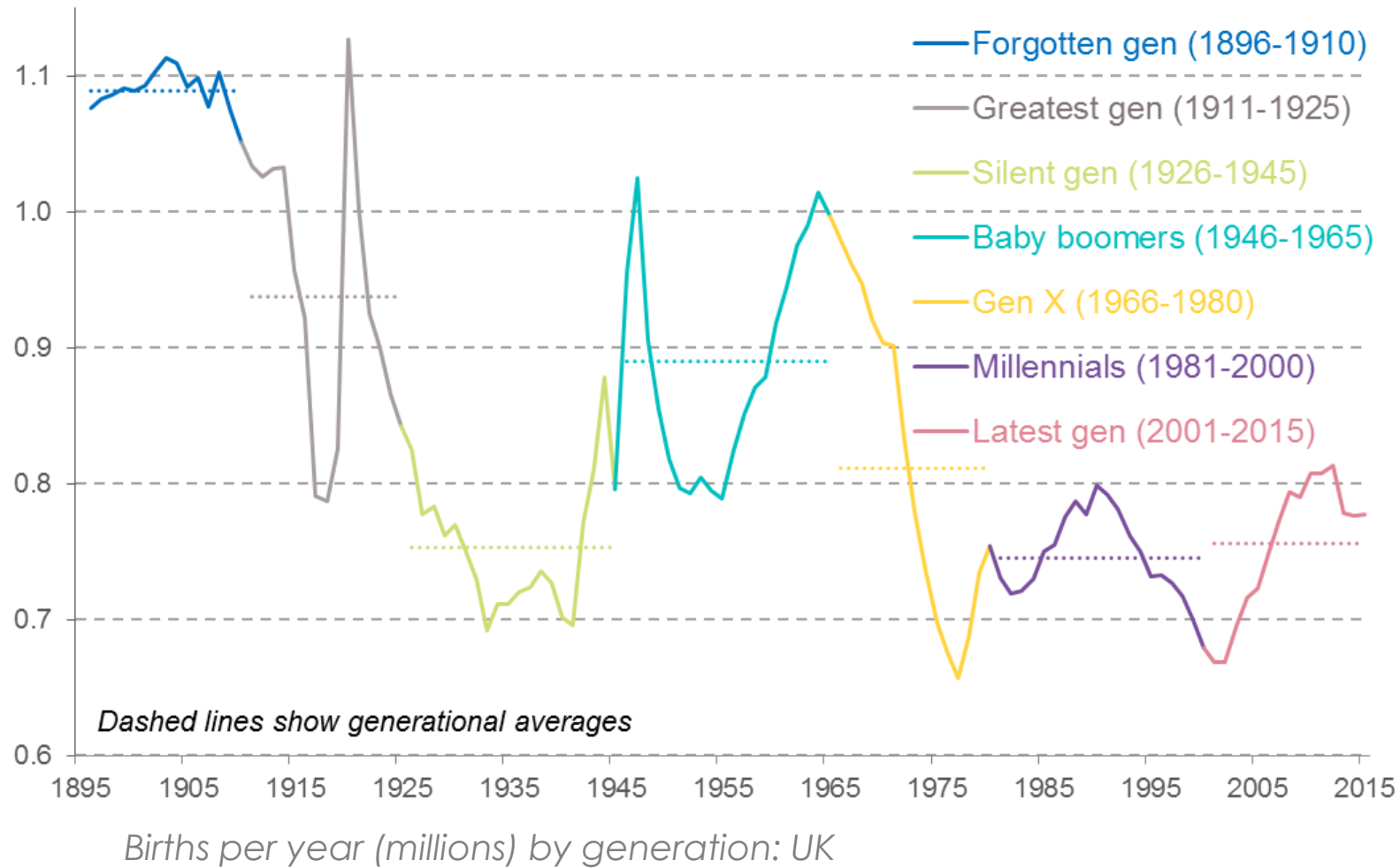

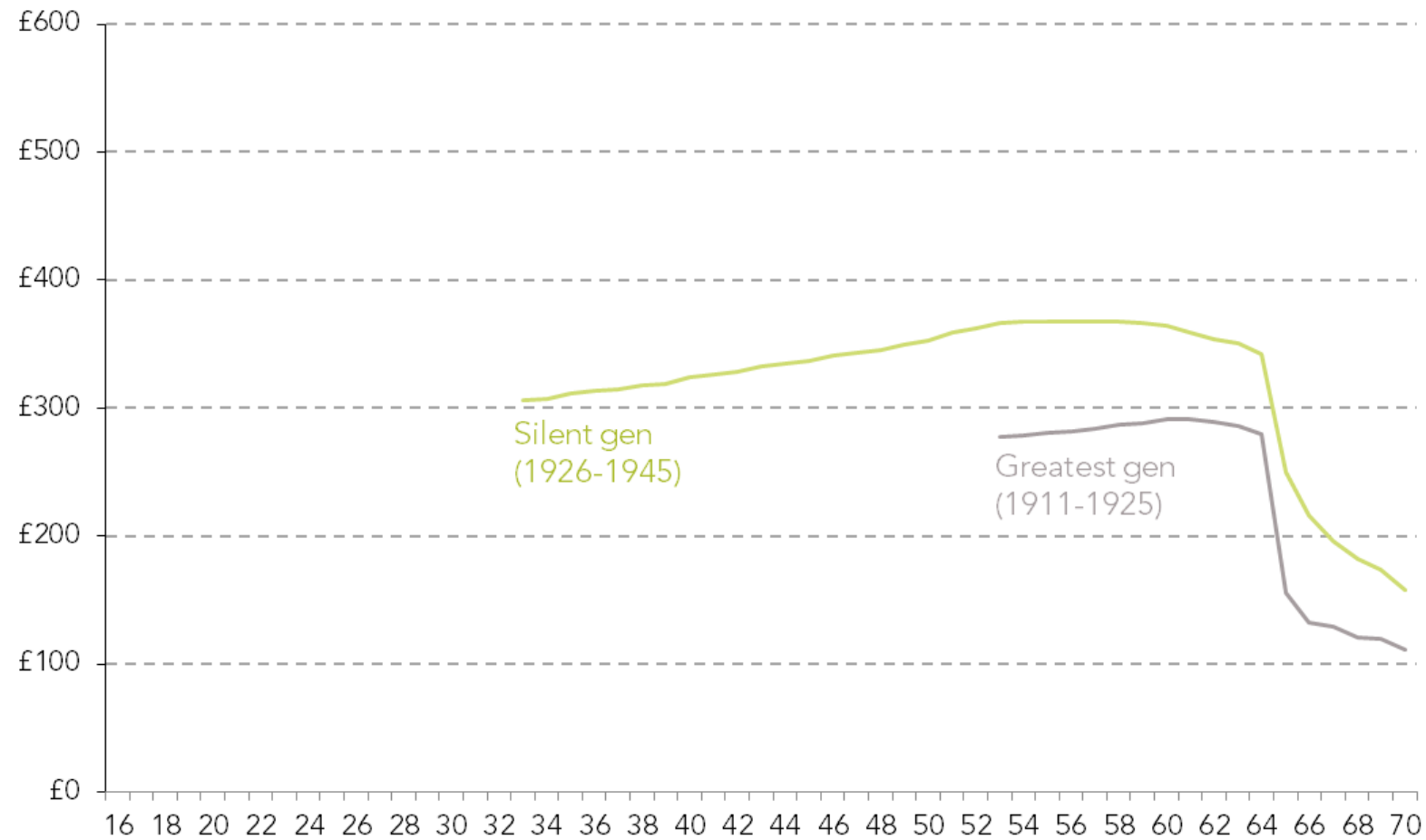

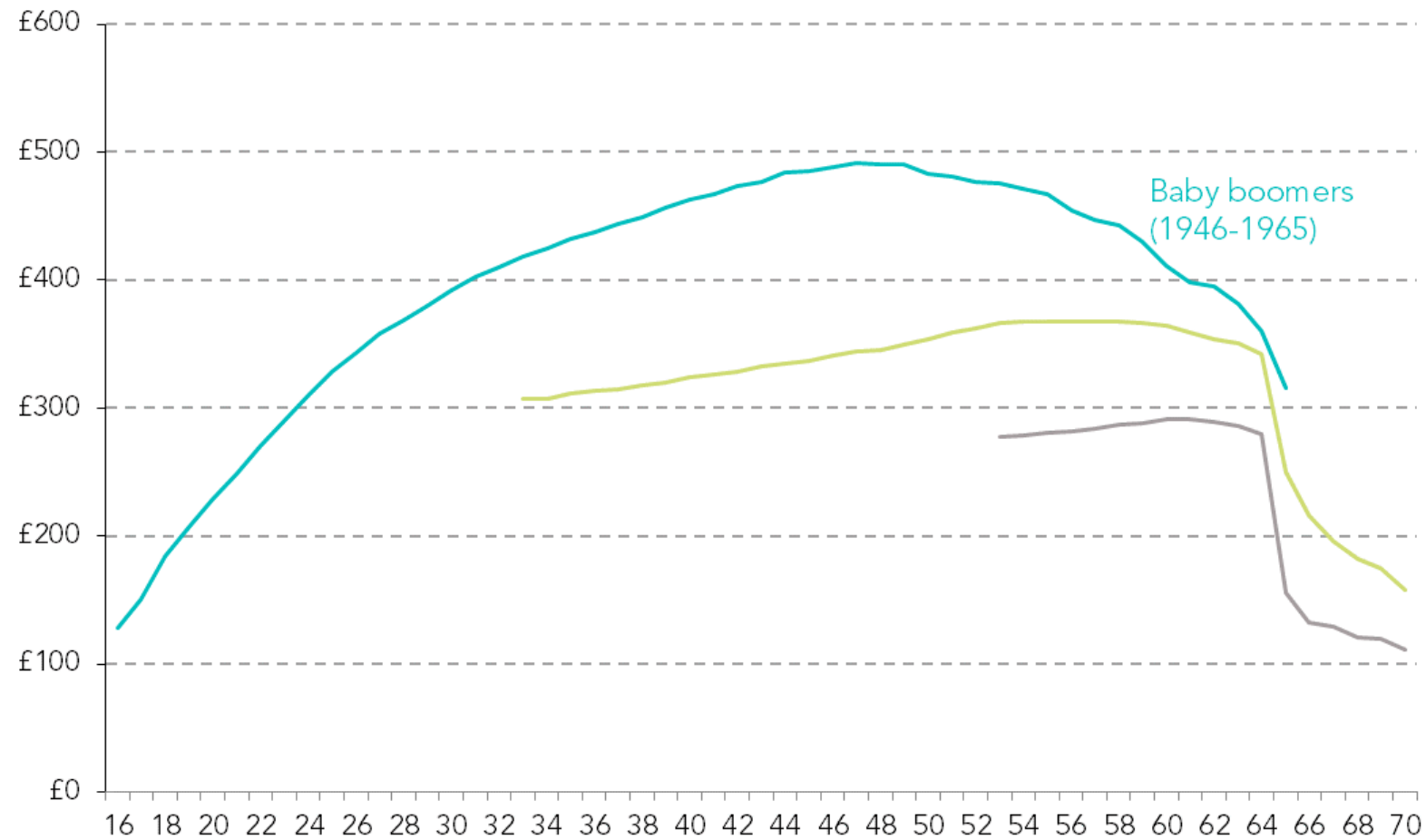


## Generational pay progress was the 20<sup>th</sup> Century norm...



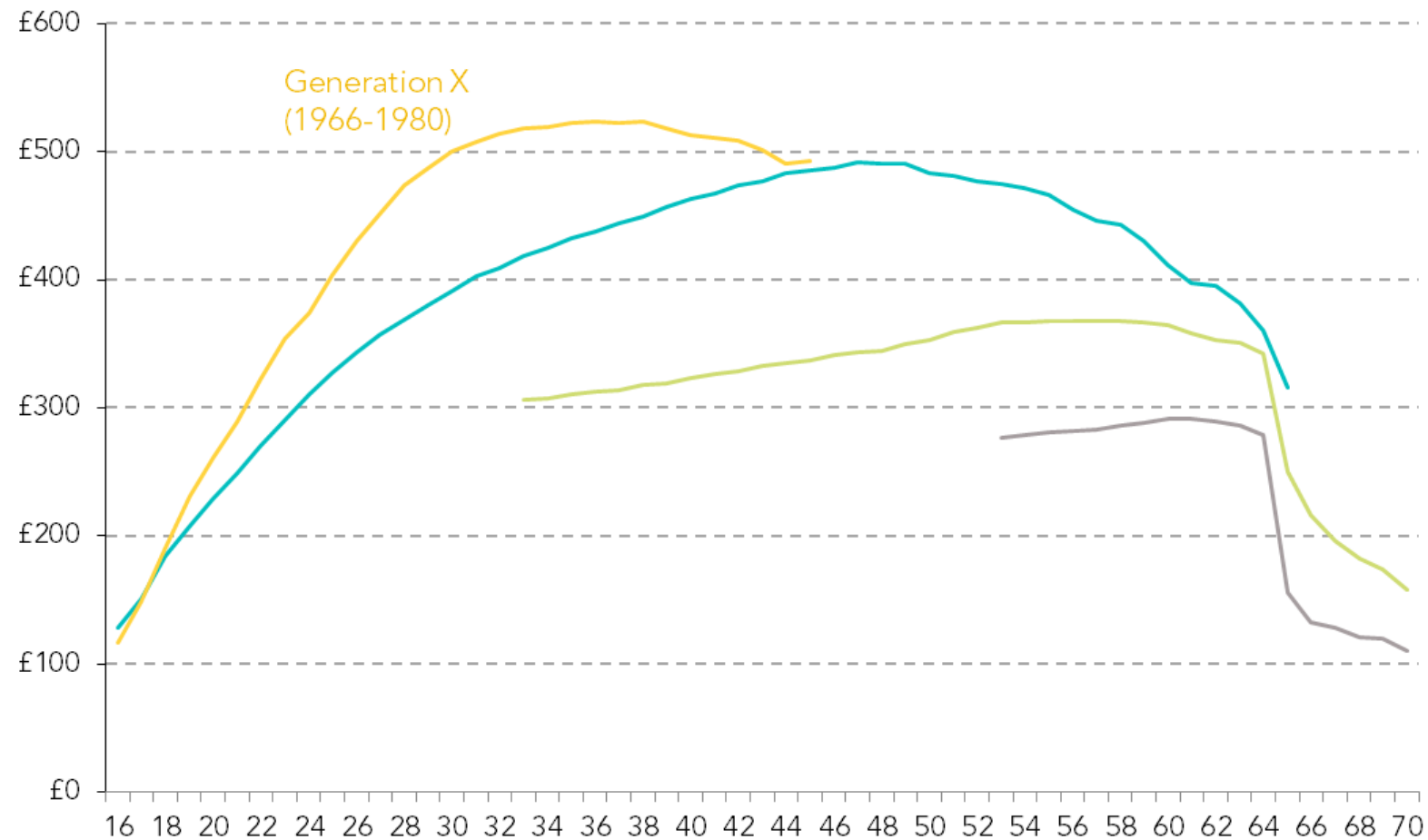
Median real weekly pay by age for each generation: UK

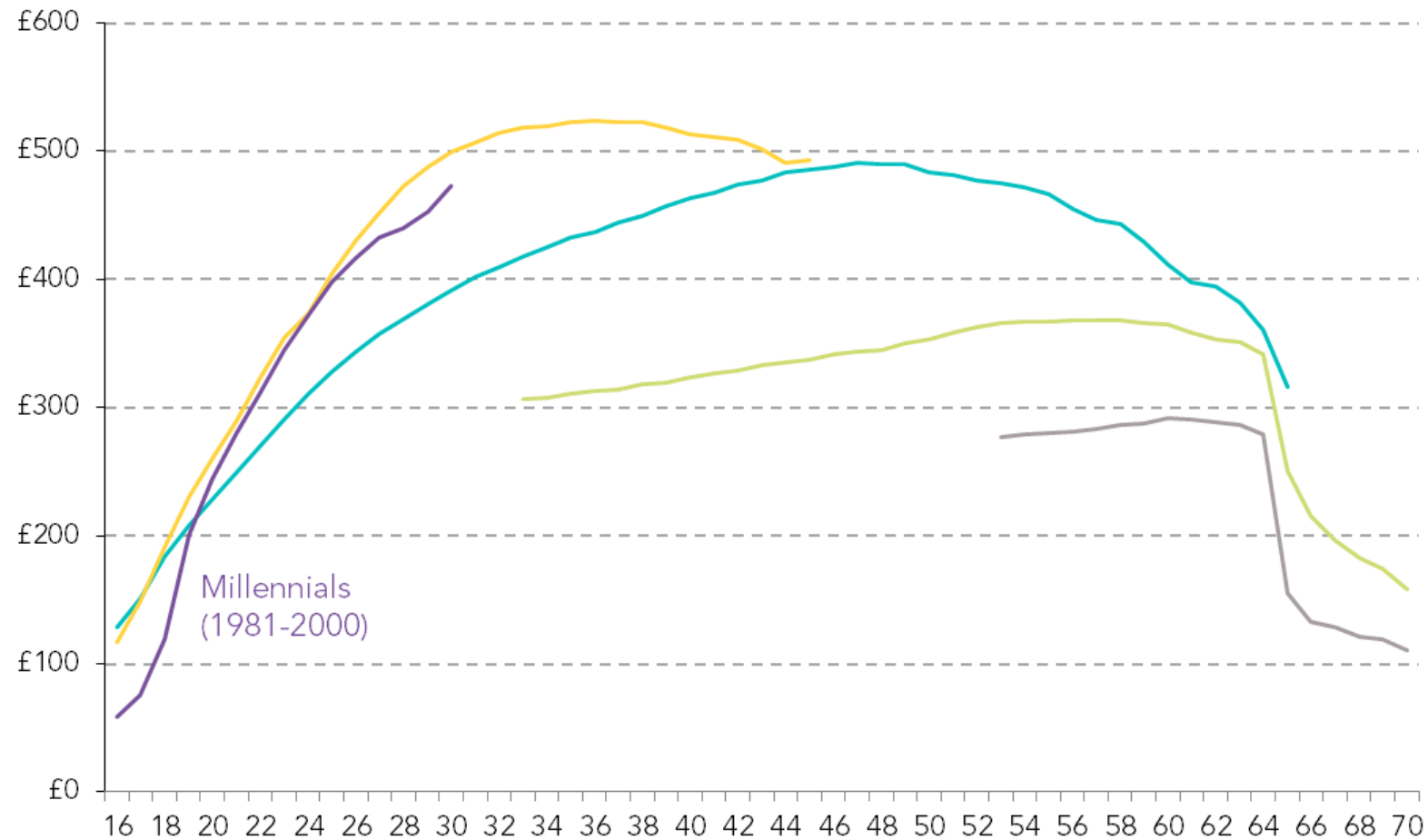

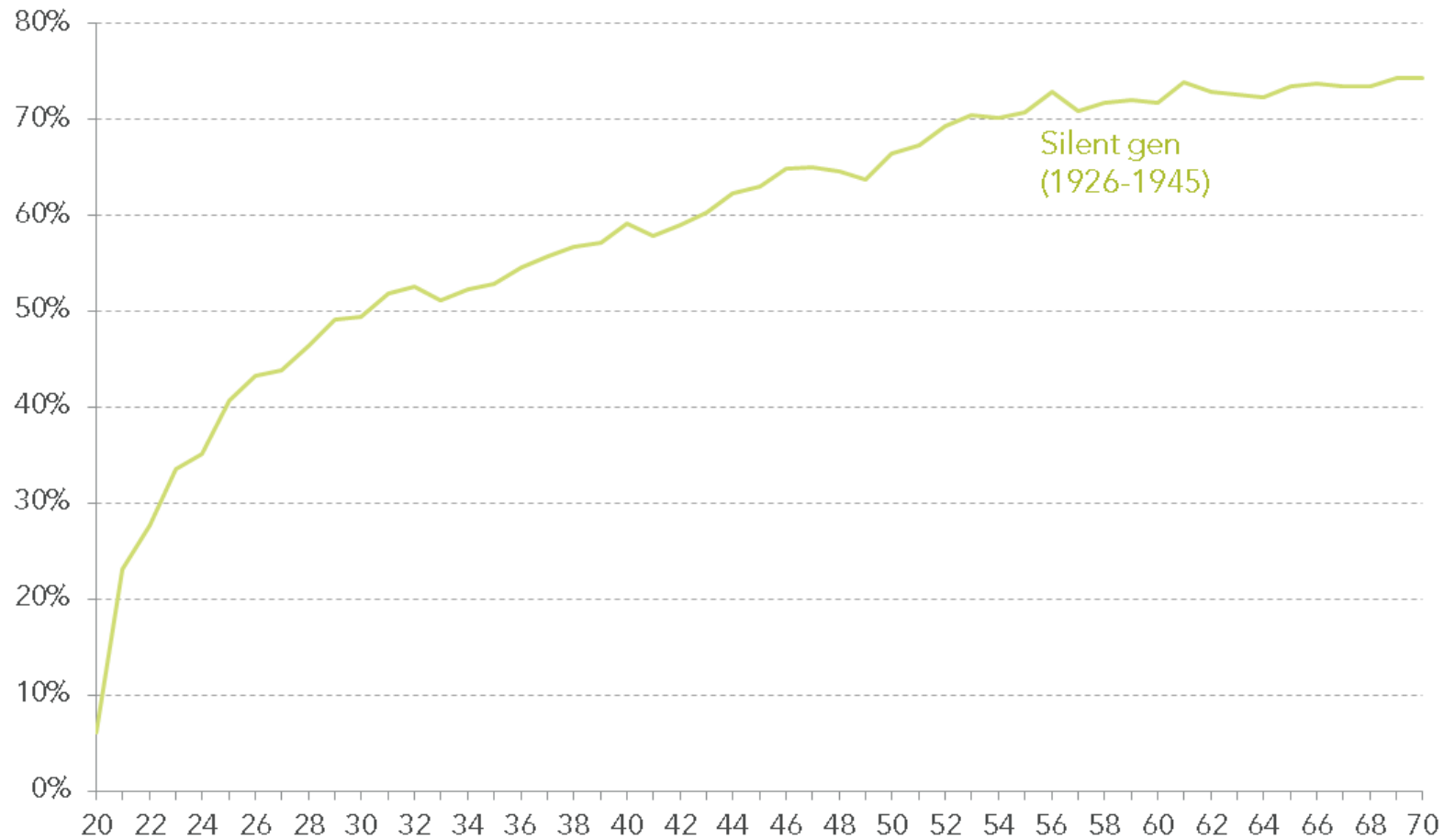

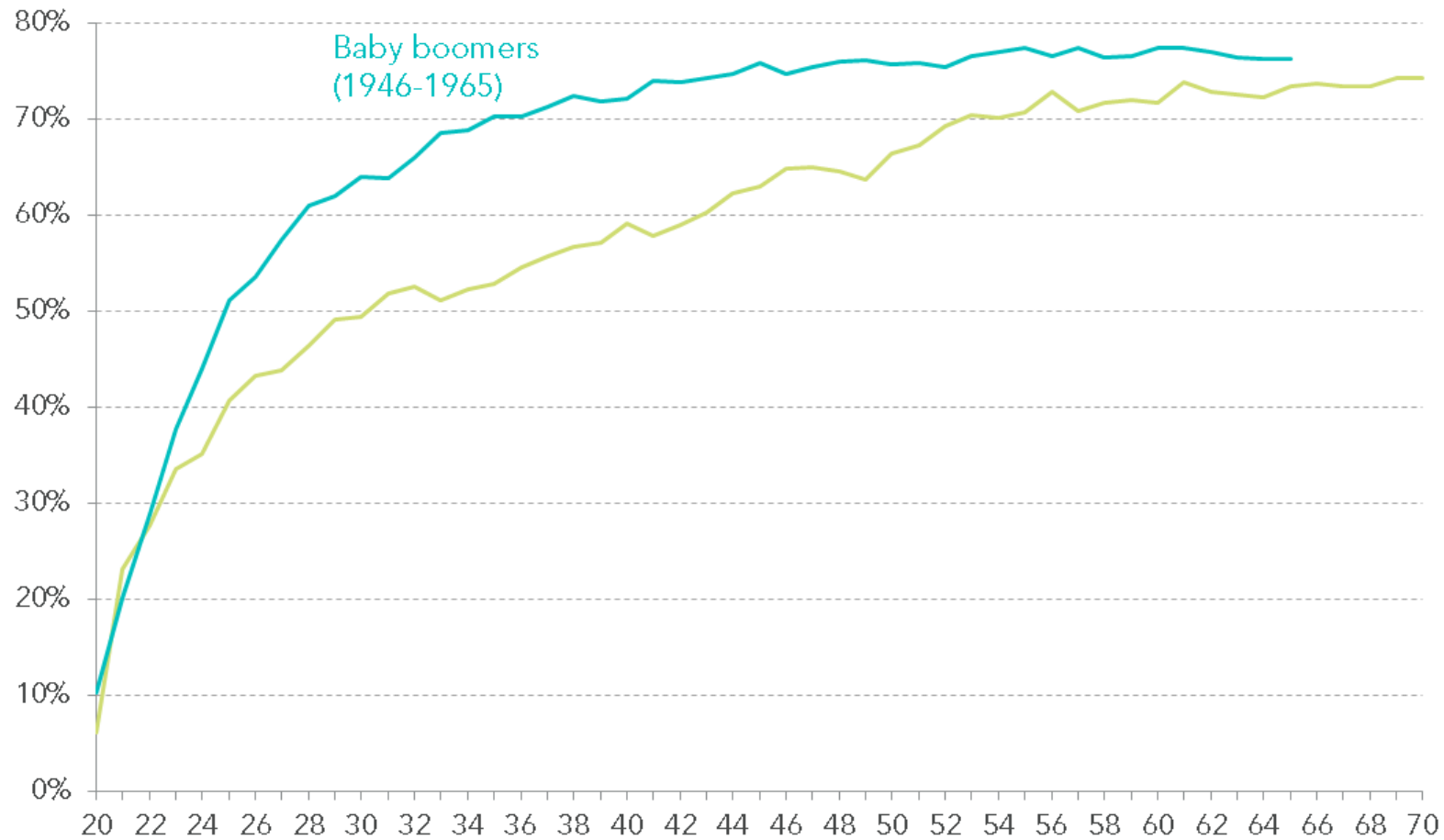
## The British home ownership rollercoaster



*Home ownership rates by age for each generation: UK*

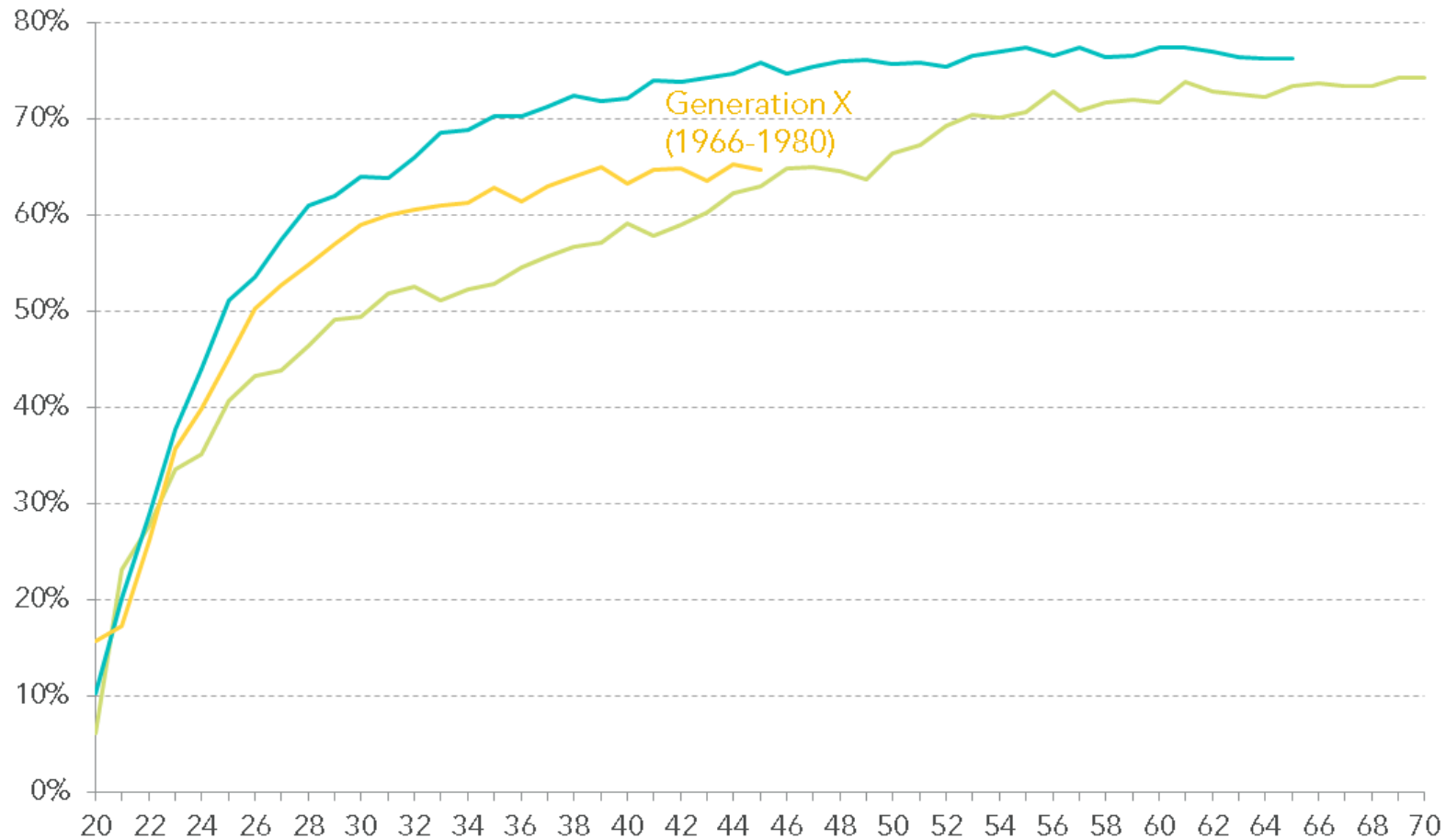

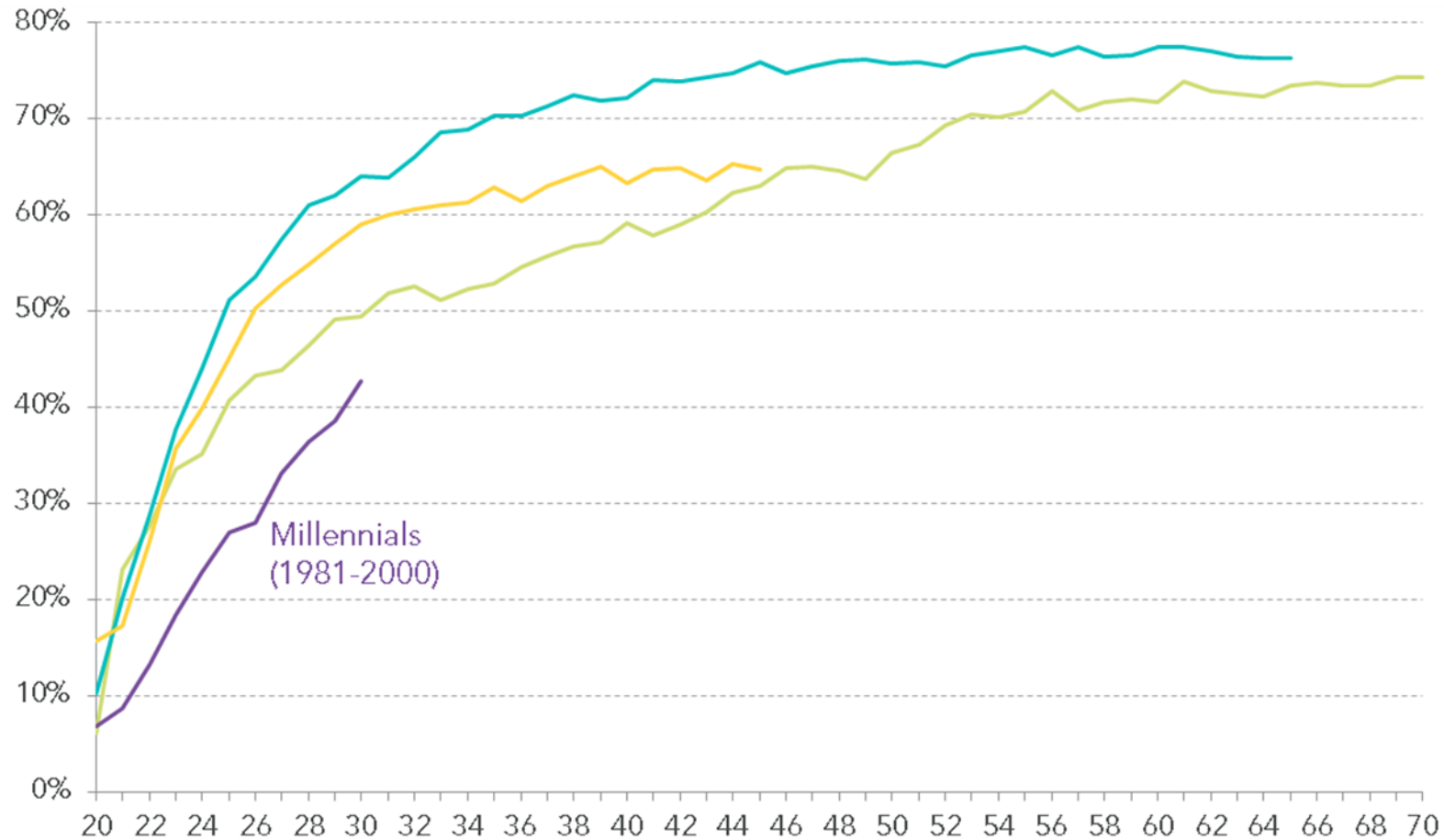

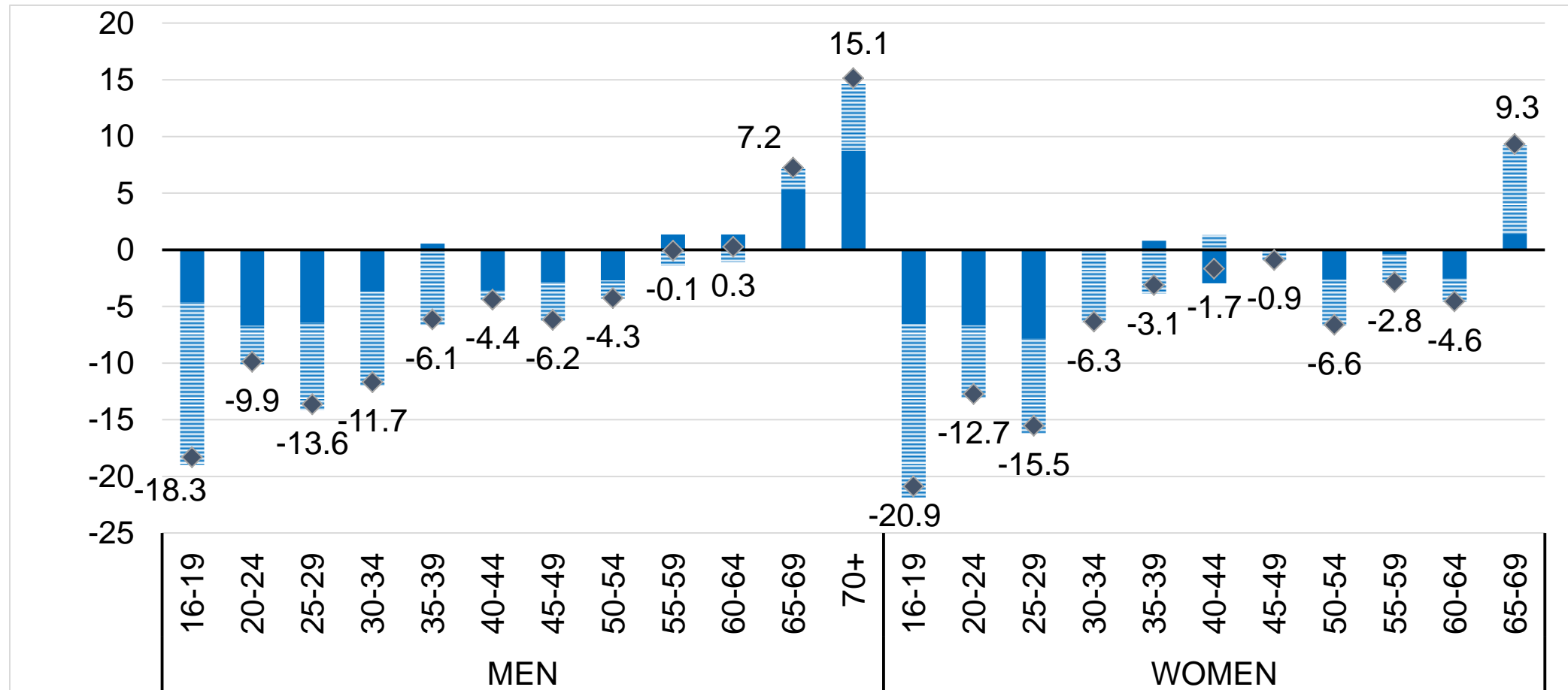

# The recession hit those born in the 1980s hardest

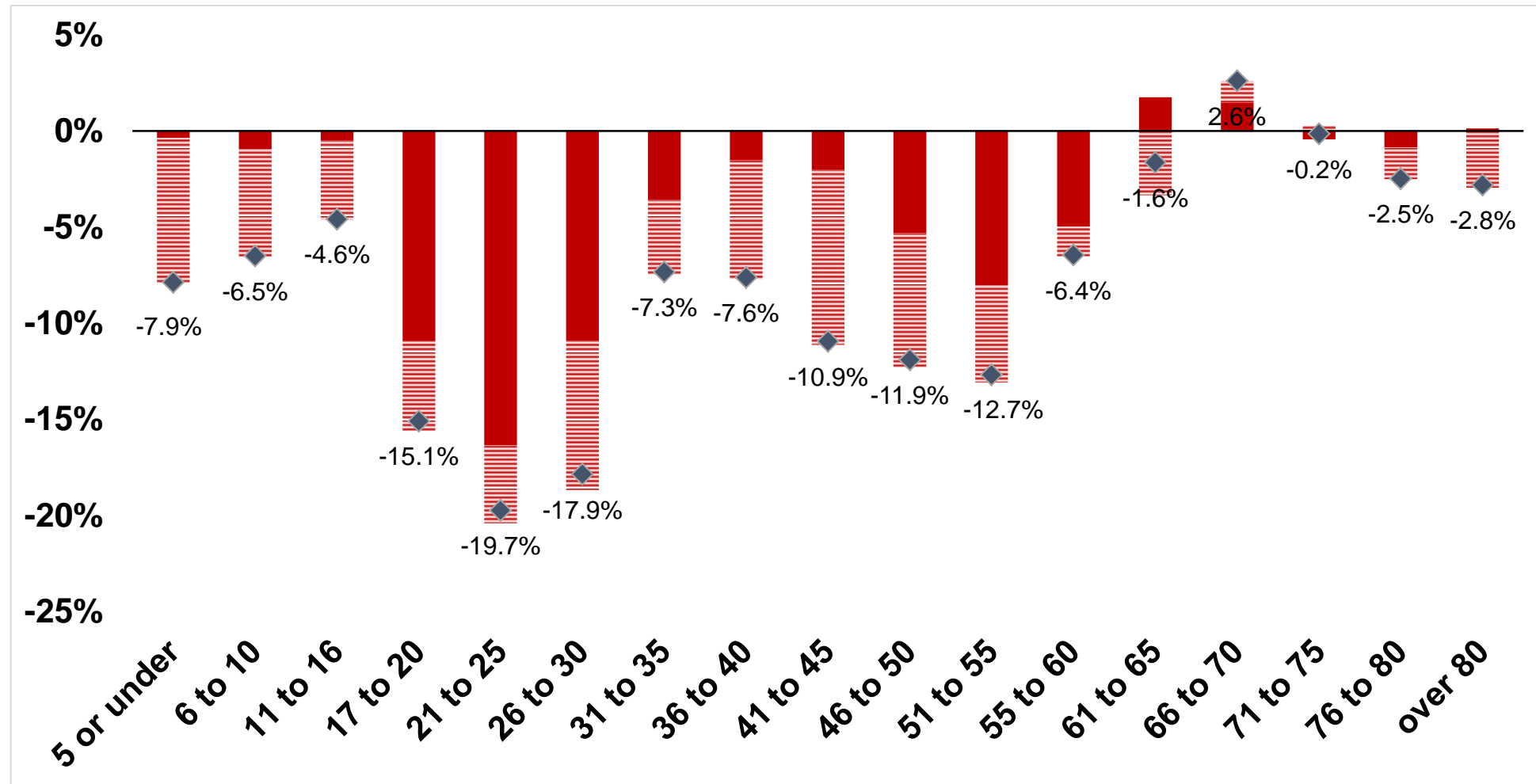
Median hourly pay by age, % change 2006-08 to 2013 (%)

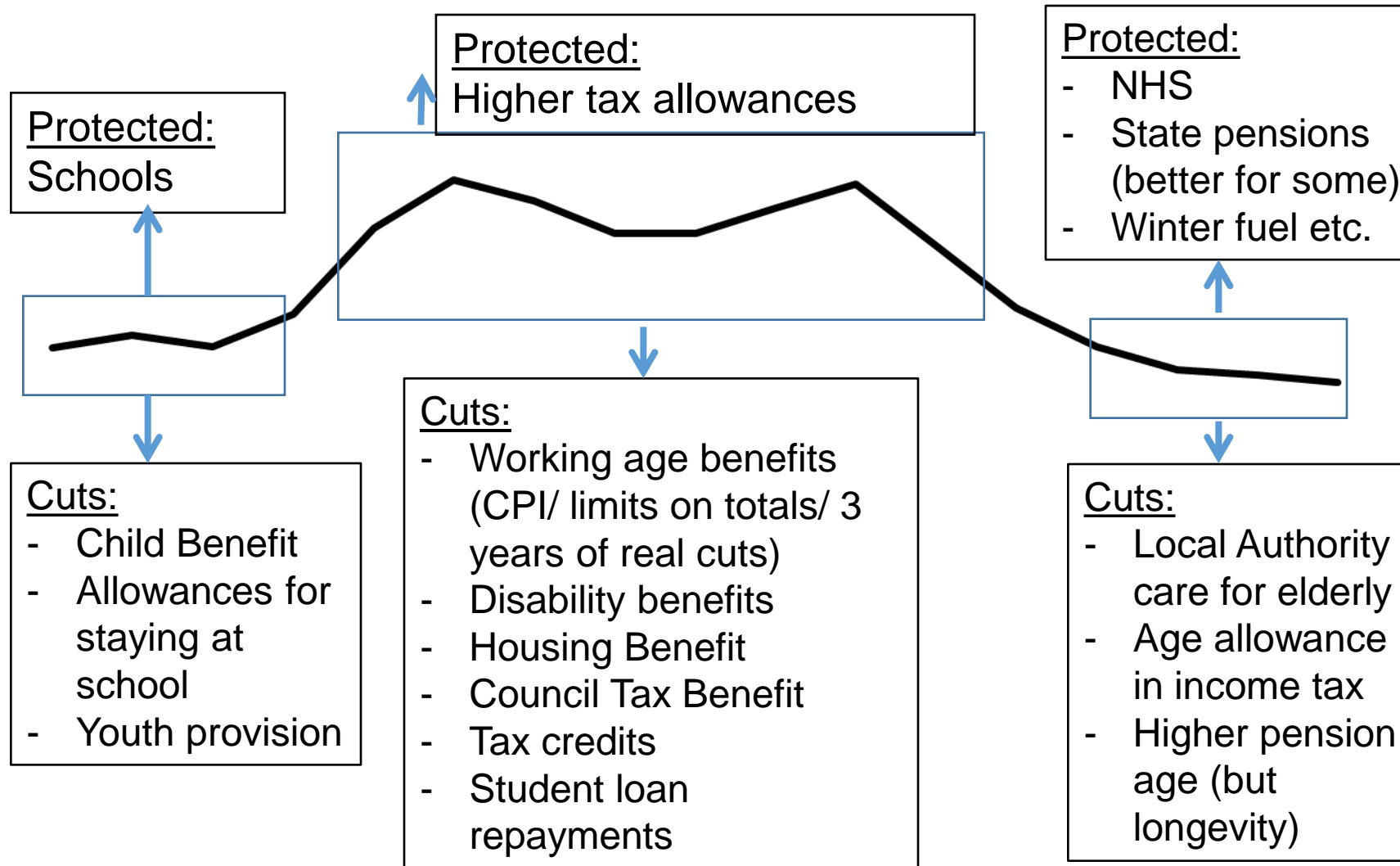
# Housing costs and benefit cuts compounded this

Change in median income after housing costs by age, 2007/8-2012/3 (%)



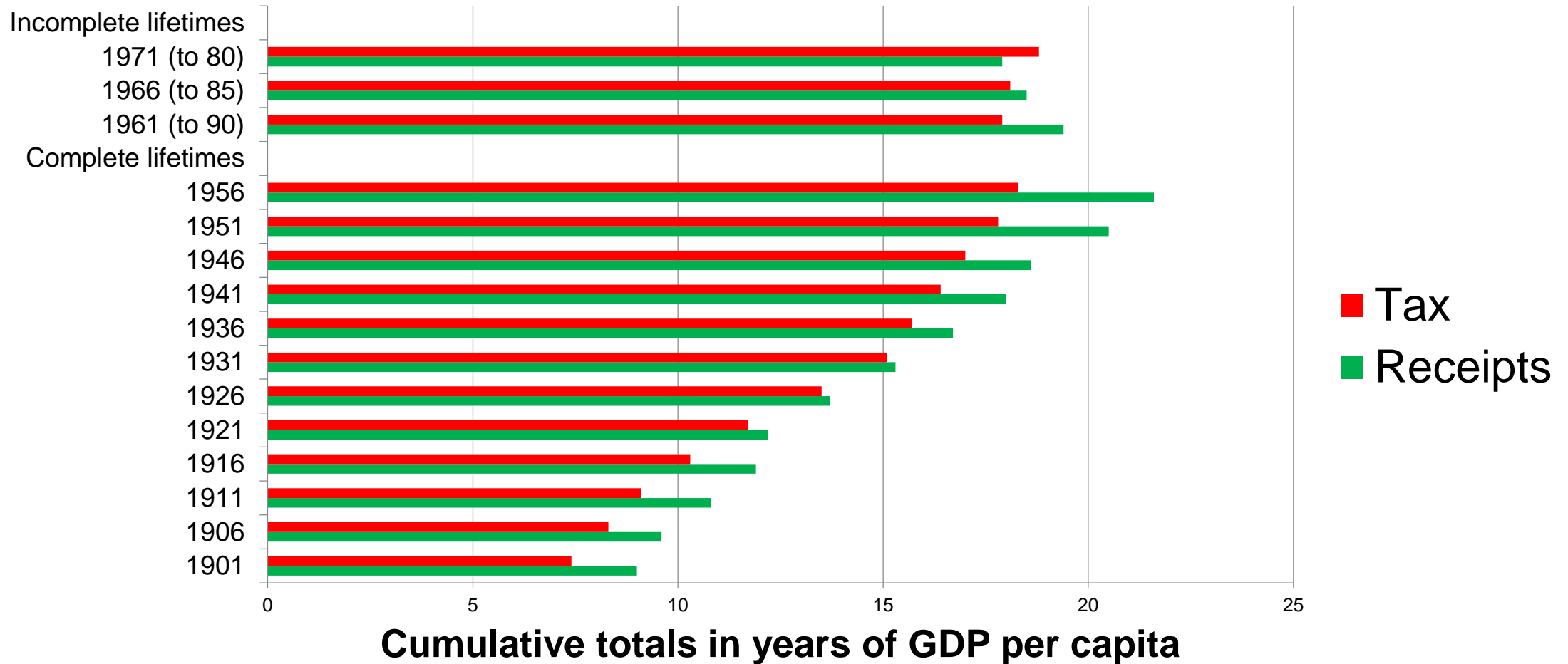

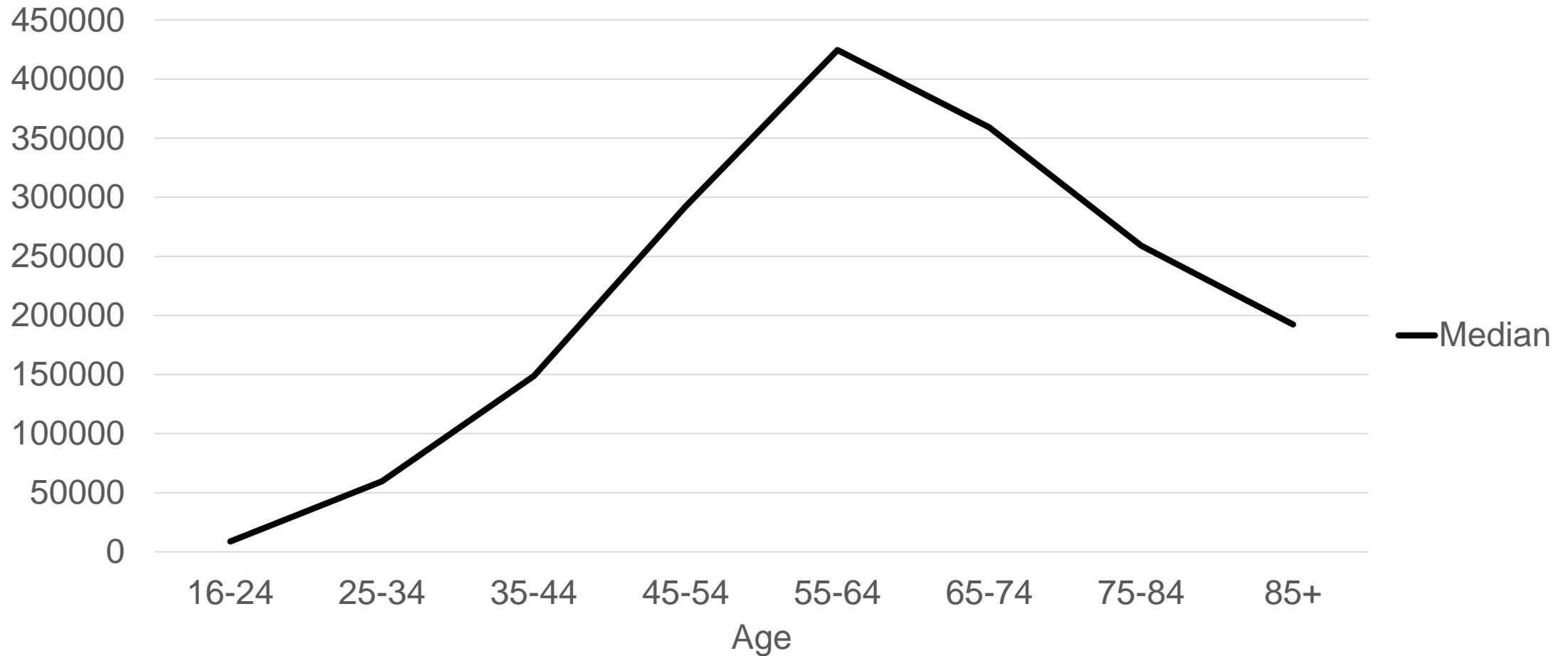
Projected lifetime receipts from health, education and social security, and taxes paid towards them by five year age cohort, 1901-2051, GB





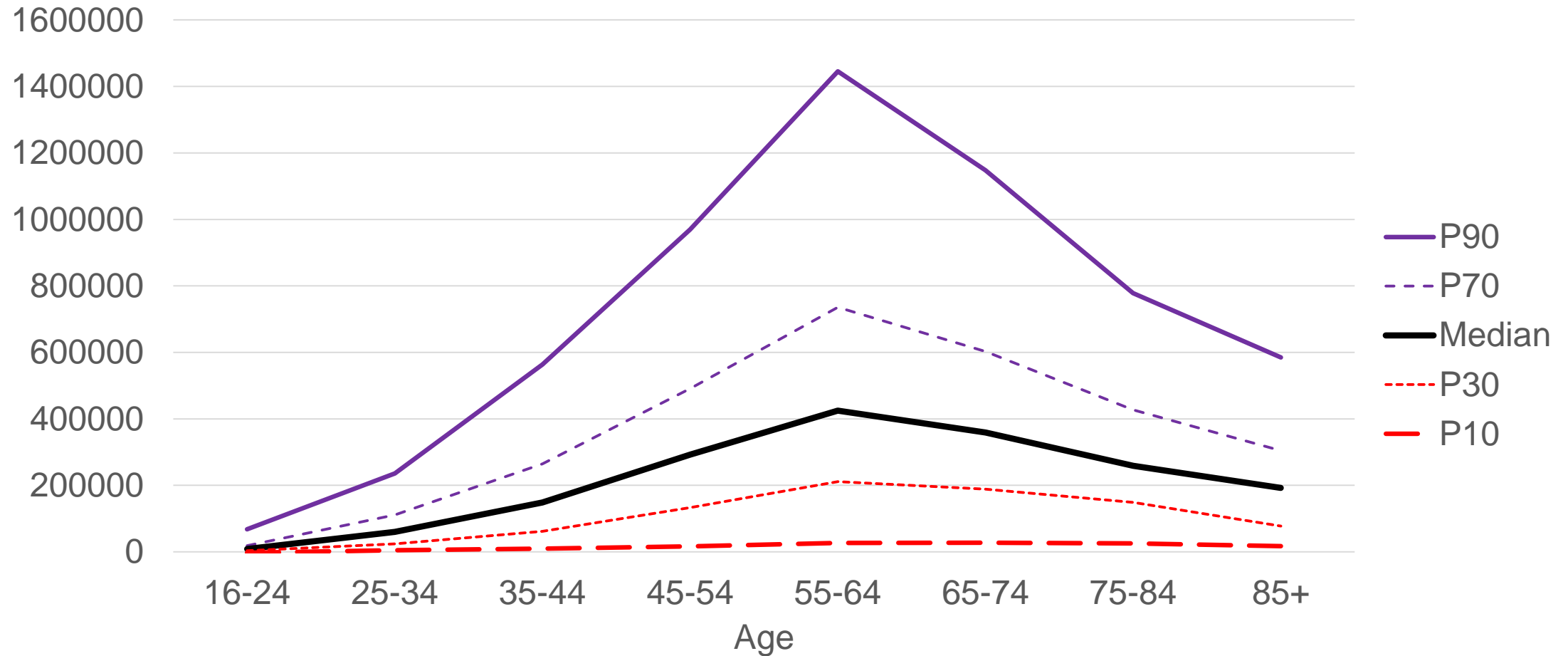
# The big issue is now wealth differences by age?

Household wealth by age, £, 2010-12



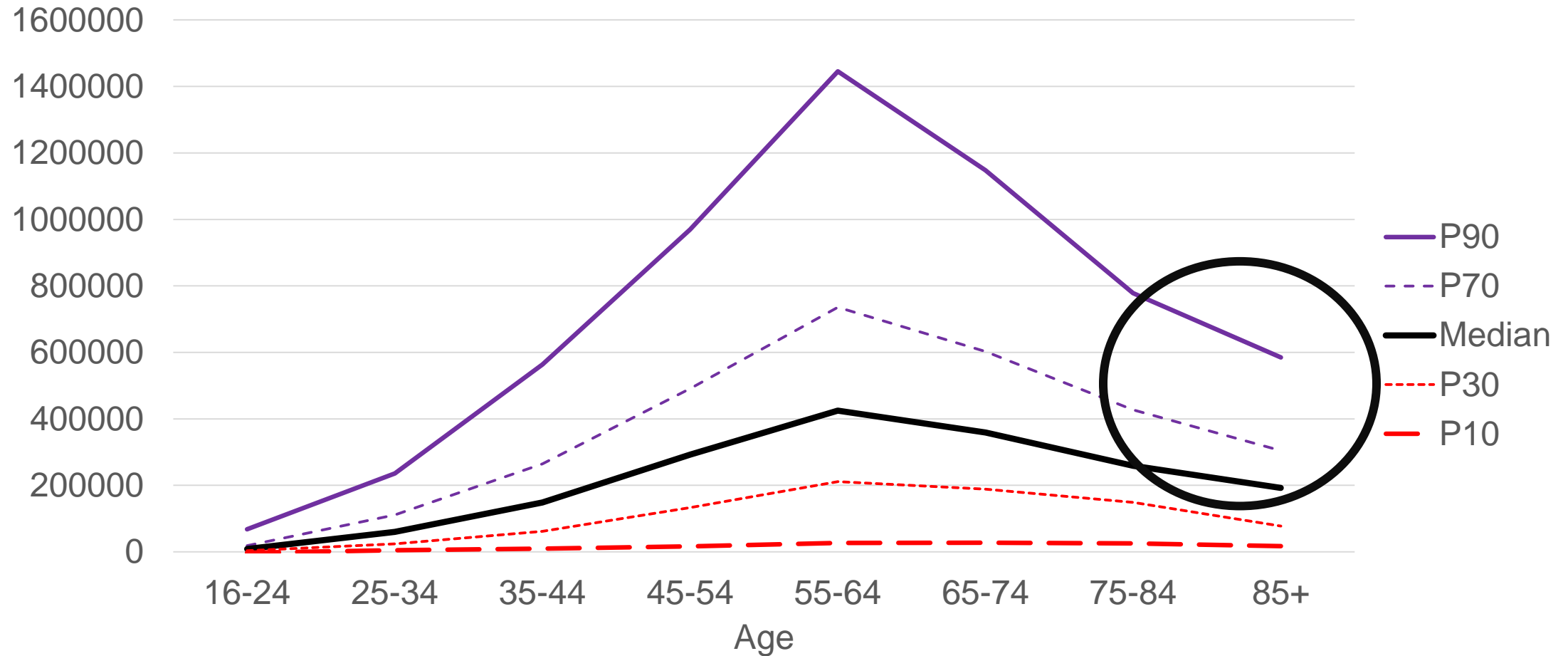
