Explores the transformations of the notion of “the people” from the late Ottoman to current Turkish political discourses

- Explores Turkish political culture and institutional architecture through archival research and a critical rereading of the historiography of the Turkish state and society
- Develops a discursive approach to populism bringing together discourse and action, and applies it to the Turkish case
- Uses and integrates modes of analysis from a diverse body of scholarship such as sociology, cultural and psychosocial studies, political science and theory into a genealogical narrative that stresses the role of societal, political, and corporeal memory in the construction of the ‘popular’

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
