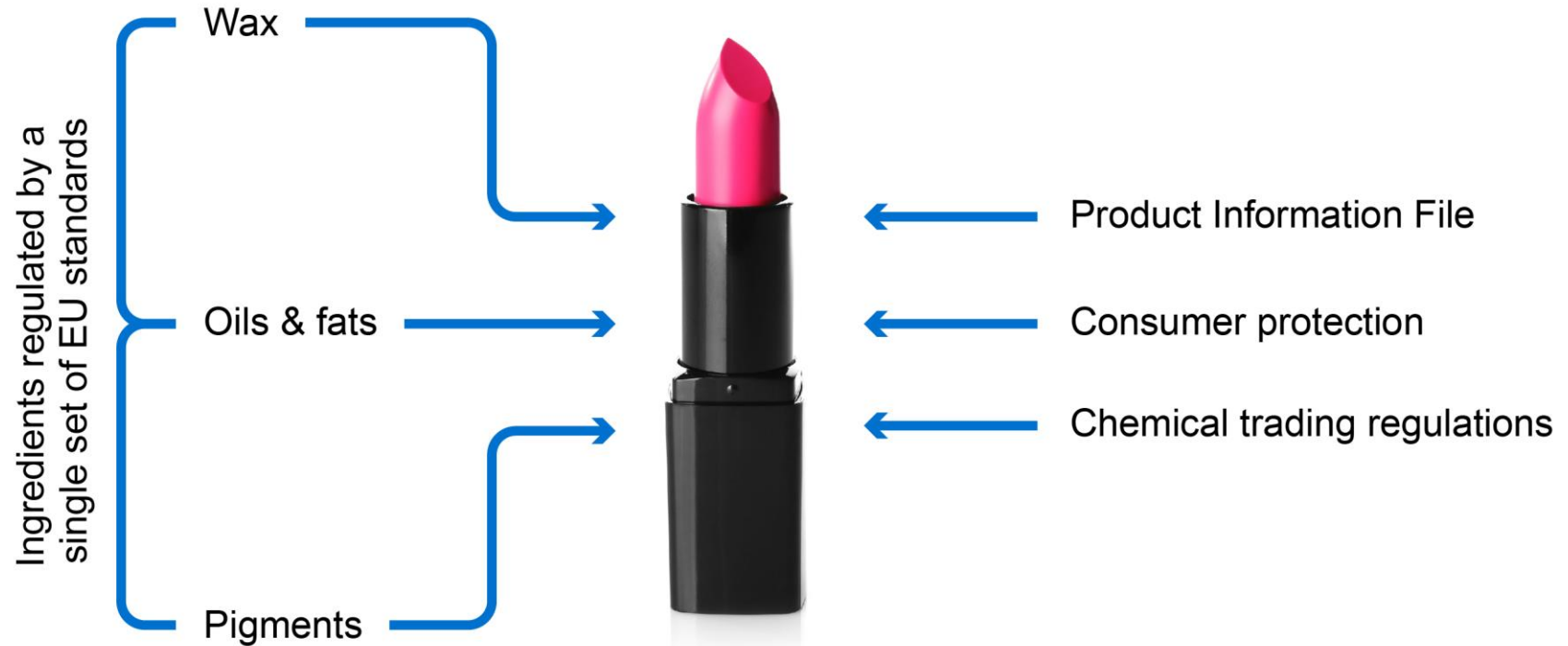

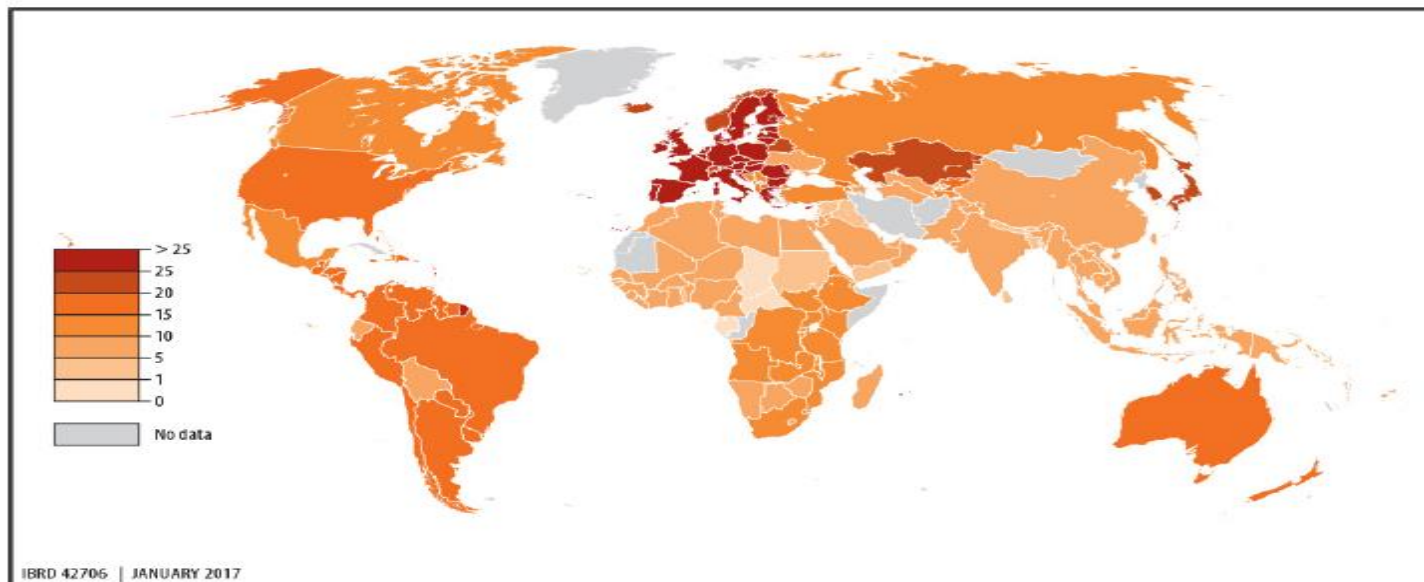

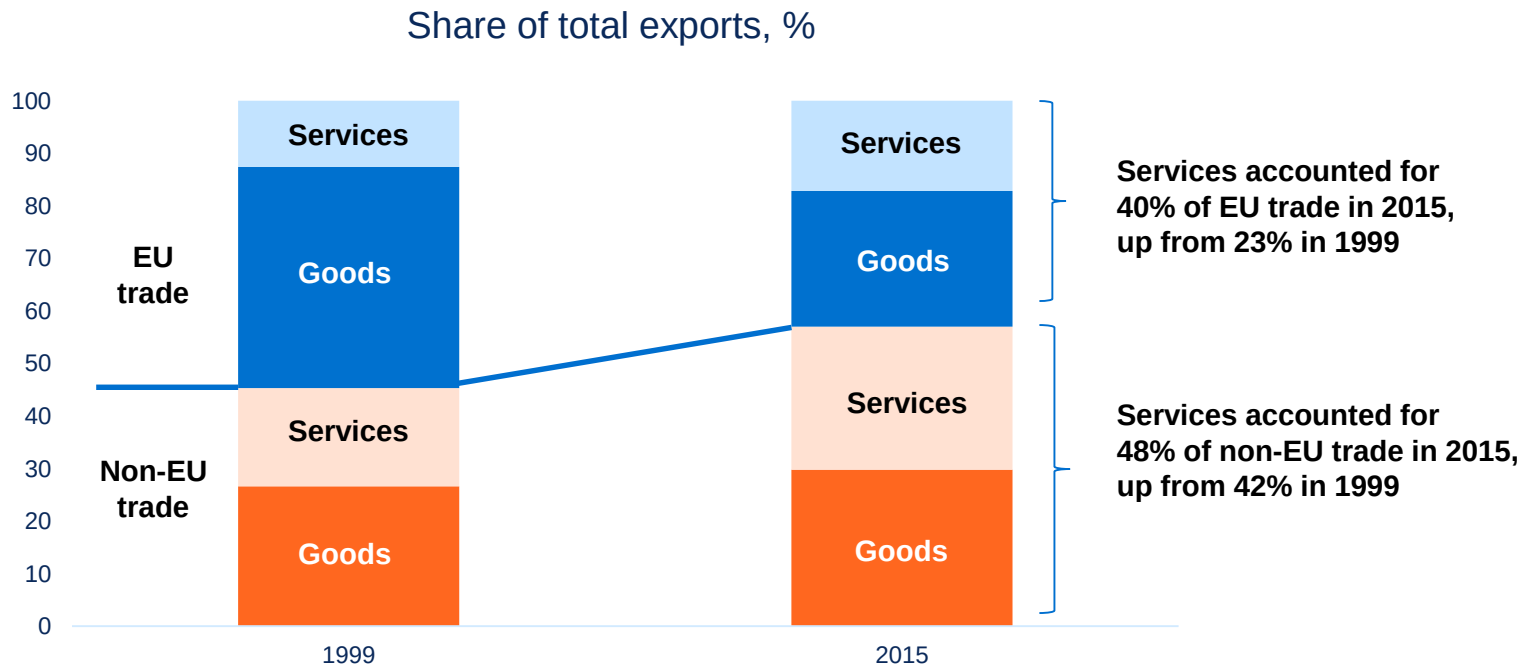


THE EU IS THE WORLD'S DEEPEST PREFERENTIAL TRADE AGREEMENT

Depth of trade agreements: number of legally enforceable provisions

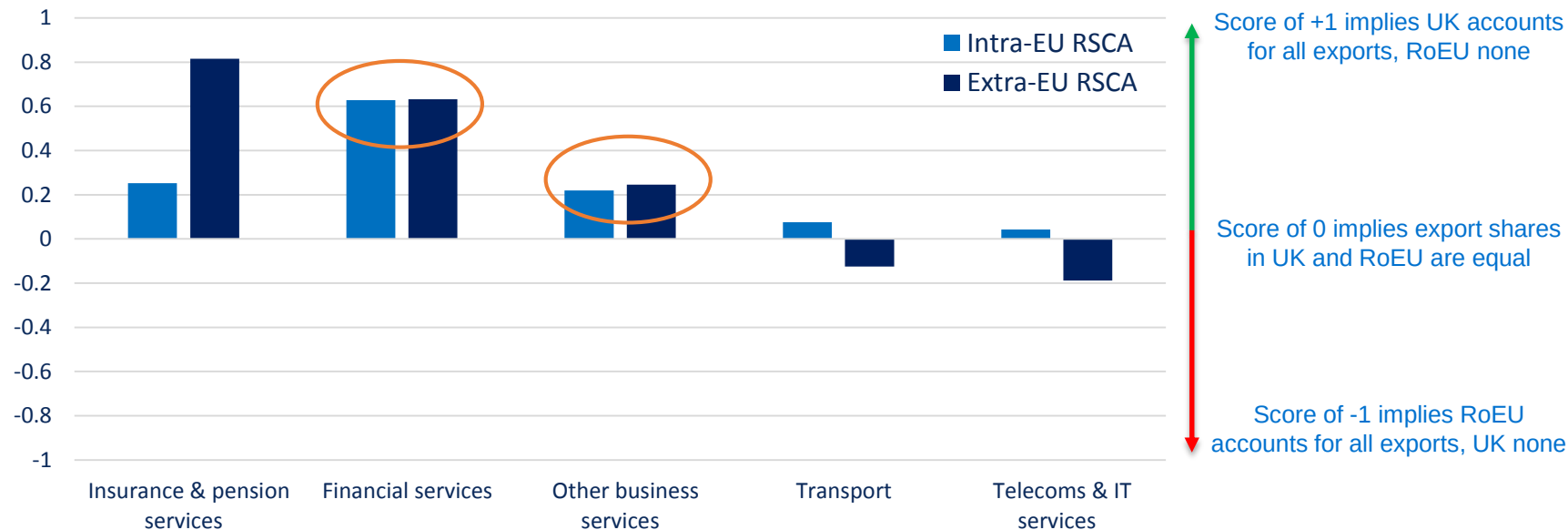


UK EXPORTS HAVE BECOME MORE FOCUSSED ON SERVICES, ESPECIALLY IN EU TRADE

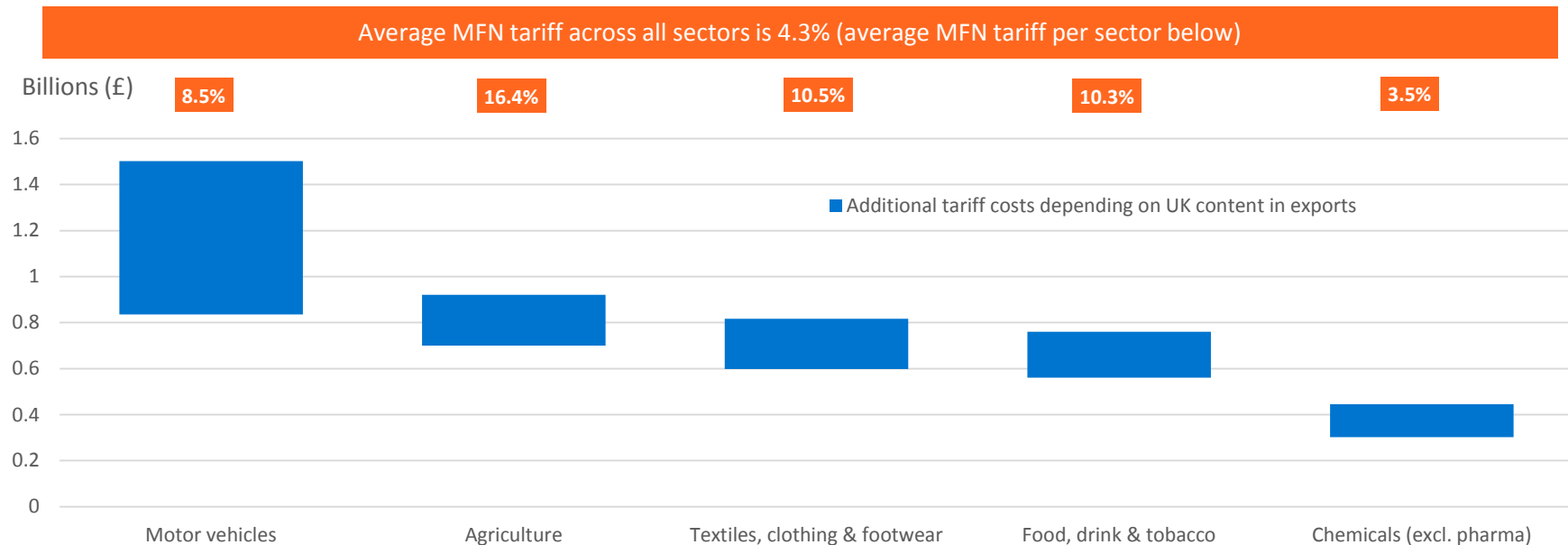


UK IS HIGHLY COMPETITIVE IN SERVICES

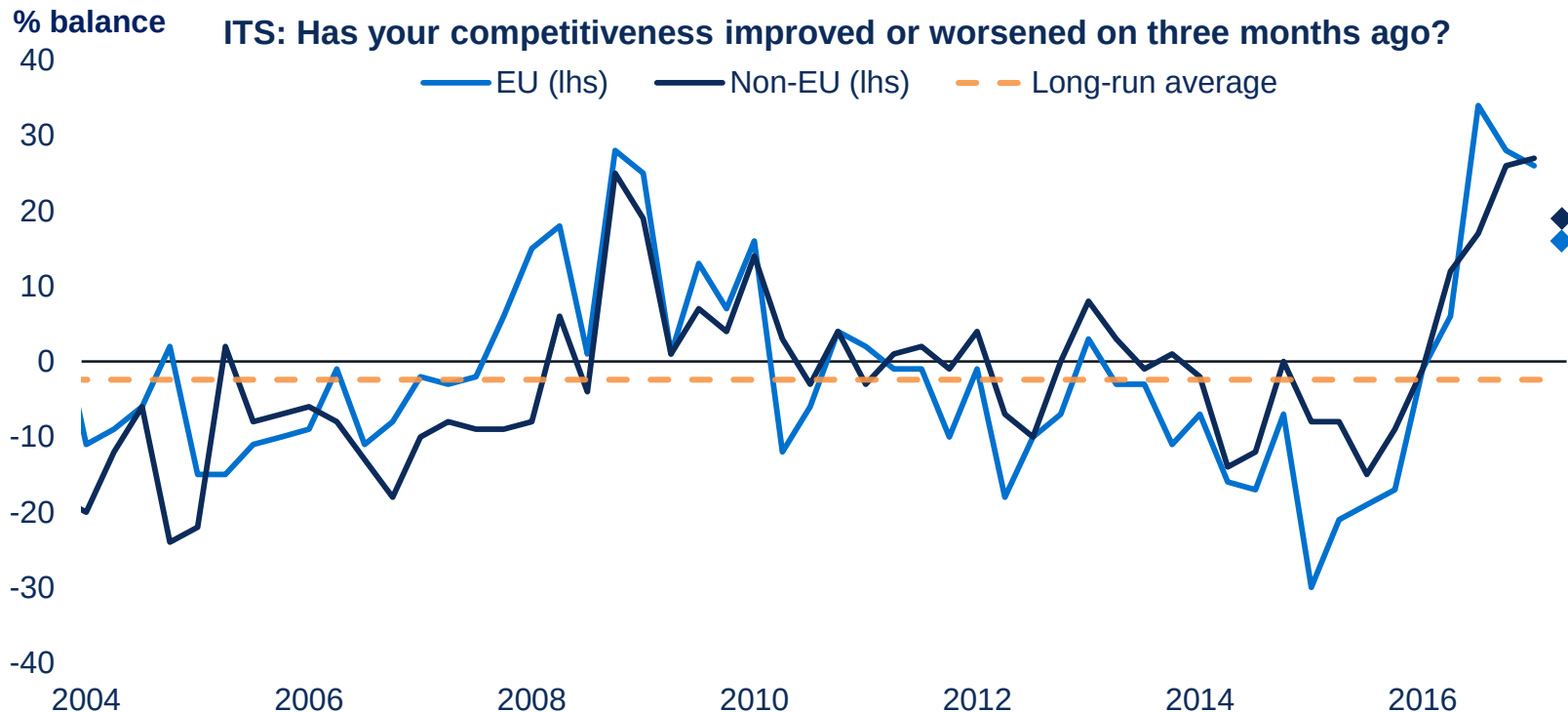
UK Revealed Comparative Advantage in intra-EU and extra-EU trade



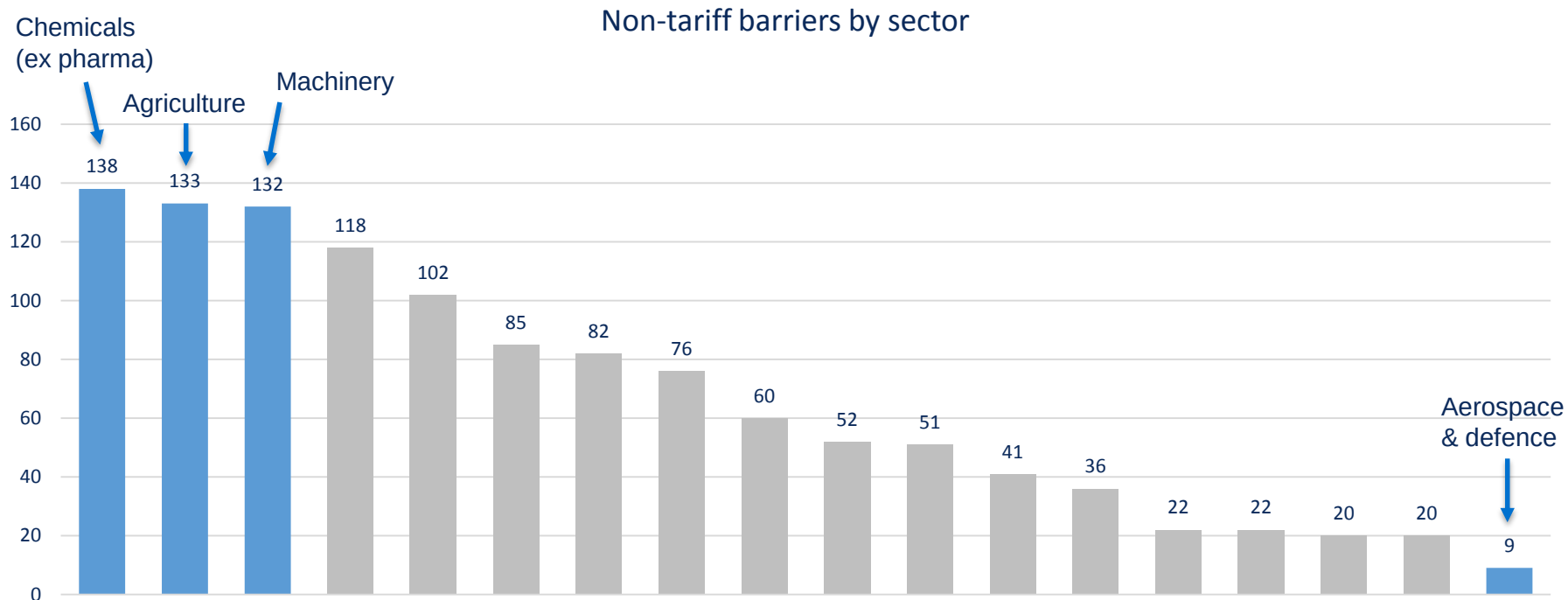
SOME SECTORS COULD SEE A SIGNIFICANT RISE IN EXPORT TARIFF COSTS



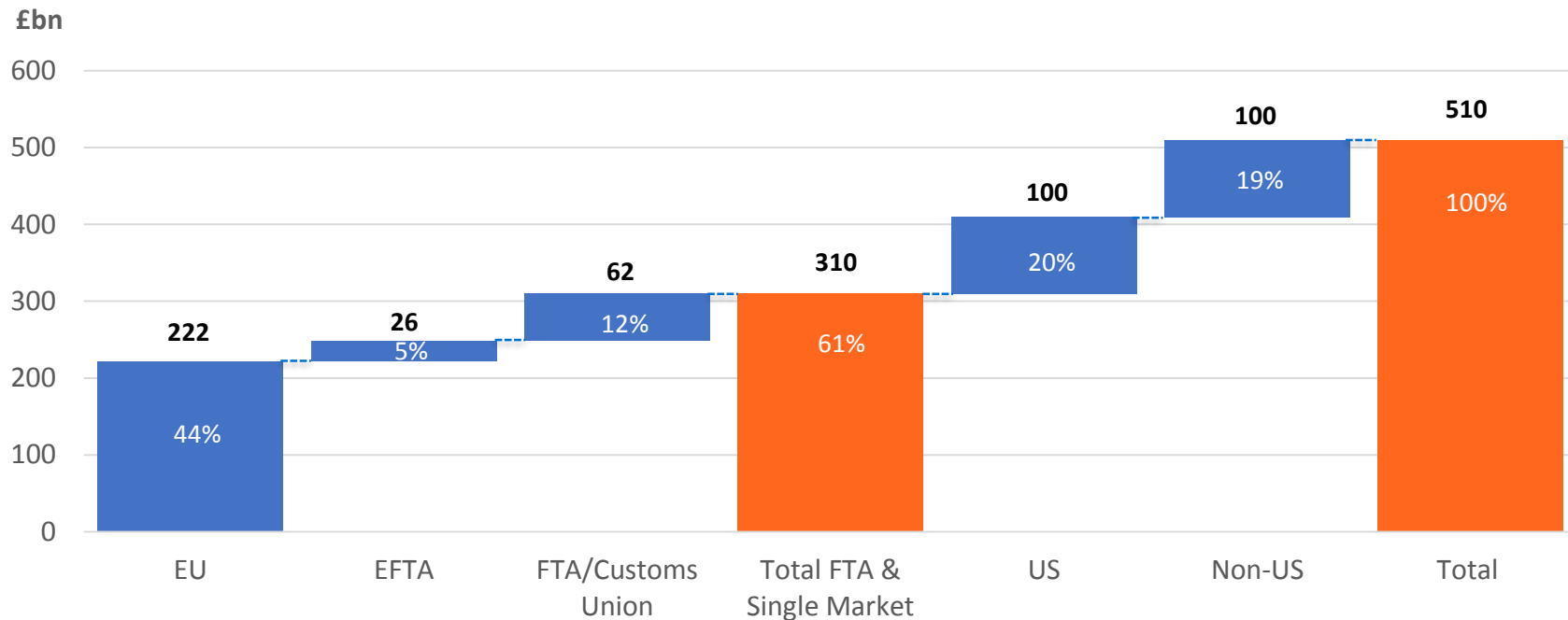
WEAKER POUND IMPROVED COMPETITIVENESS
