Remembering can be difficult when it includes people that have died - our emotions are not predictable. People also feel and express things in different ways. Sometimes creating something that will be a memorial is a good way of working out what we are thinking and feeling.

As a country we have **memorials** to remember people died due to war, disaster or from natural causes. They can be statues, sculptures, plaques and gardens.

We can make our own memorials to remember someone, but also to show everyone else who they were, what they loved doing, what they might have done for a job. A celebration of them and what they mean to you.

These activities below are there to help you sort out what you would like to include into your memorial. There is no right or wrong way to design your own memorial, the important thing to remember is that this is your personal piece.

Who would you like to remember and make your memorial about?

Write down their name, it could be their nickname. If you don't have someone in mind, think about how you'd like the people who died during the COVID-19 Pandemic to be remembered.

What do you think you would like to share about the person you are thinking about? Would it be what they looked like? Or what they liked to do? If you knew them did they have a special skill or something they said all the time?
