

Wikimedian in Residence and Research Visibility Champion

Progress and Impact Summary, June 2026

- Delivered three Wikipedia workshops for researchers: dementia caregiving, blue economy, and Media and Communications.
 - Engaged **14 workshop participants**, improved **15 Wikipedia articles** and added **4,830 words**.
 - Cited **21 LSE research papers 59 times** across improved Wikipedia articles, included OA links through LSERO.
 - Articles edited at the [dementia caregiving workshop](#) received **211,480 pageviews** between 21 April and 18 June.
- Wide ranging engagement from across the School, including Gender, Geography and Environment, Grantham, International History, Sociology, and Psychological and Behavioural Science.
- Two further Wikipedia articles updated through collaboration with two researchers. Entries received **12,000 pageviews** since editing.
- Created internal and external facing documentation, including [baseline statistics](#) for tracking progress, and a [Wikimedian service guide](#) for the LSE website.
- Delivered **eight internal presentations** about WiR & RVC role.
- Started workshop planning with **three departments** and **eight researchers**.
- External engagement including presentations at **the London Open Science and Scholarship Festival** and the **CIVICA Open Science Conference**, and participation in Wikimedia and REF working group.
- Supported Library colleagues working with LSE images on Wikimedia Commons:
 - Number of Wikipedia articles using LSE images: **1,901 → 3,238**
 - Global Wikipedia monthly pageviews for articles using LSE images: **1.92 million → 3.28 million**
- Published **two guides** for researchers on [Altmetric](#) and [Overton](#).
- Rewrote LSE's Citation analysis and research visibility [web page](#).
- Delivered an Altmetric workshop (**12 participants**)
