Job title: Graduate Teaching Assistant

Department/Division: Economics Accountable to: Head of Department

Job Summary: The Department expects that the main duties of Graduate Teaching Assistants will be undergraduate level class teaching and associated duties, and exam marking.

Main Duties and Responsibilities

TEACHING:

- Contributing to the scholarship and intellectual life of the School by conducting teaching which will enhance the School's high reputation as a research-led teaching institution.
- To take responsibility for the quality of teaching delivered and as necessary to seek further training, guidance and skills development to ensure that standards are maintained and improved.
- Teaching undergraduate level students through classes and specialized support sessions.
- Holding regular weekly office hours and being available to students by appointment.
- Marking and providing feedback on formative work (problem sets, essays) during the academic year.
- Marking summative work (exam scripts).
- Participating in regular teaching meetings, with academics and administrators involved in the course(s).
- Identifying learning needs of students and defining appropriate learning objectives.

ADMINISTRATION:

- Managing academic administration arising from teaching responsibilities, e.g. undertaking class preparation and marking, with guidance, as required.
- Assisting with the development of course materials i.e. minor drafting tasks, proof-reading, revising and updating lecture notes, problem sets and solutions.
- Proof-reading and testing exam papers, providing feedback on questions and drafting potential solutions for examiners.
- Provision of frontline support to students.
- Recording student attendance in the class registers on LSE for You on a weekly basis.
- Writing termly class teacher and advisor reports on LSE for You, providing useful qualitative information on each student.
