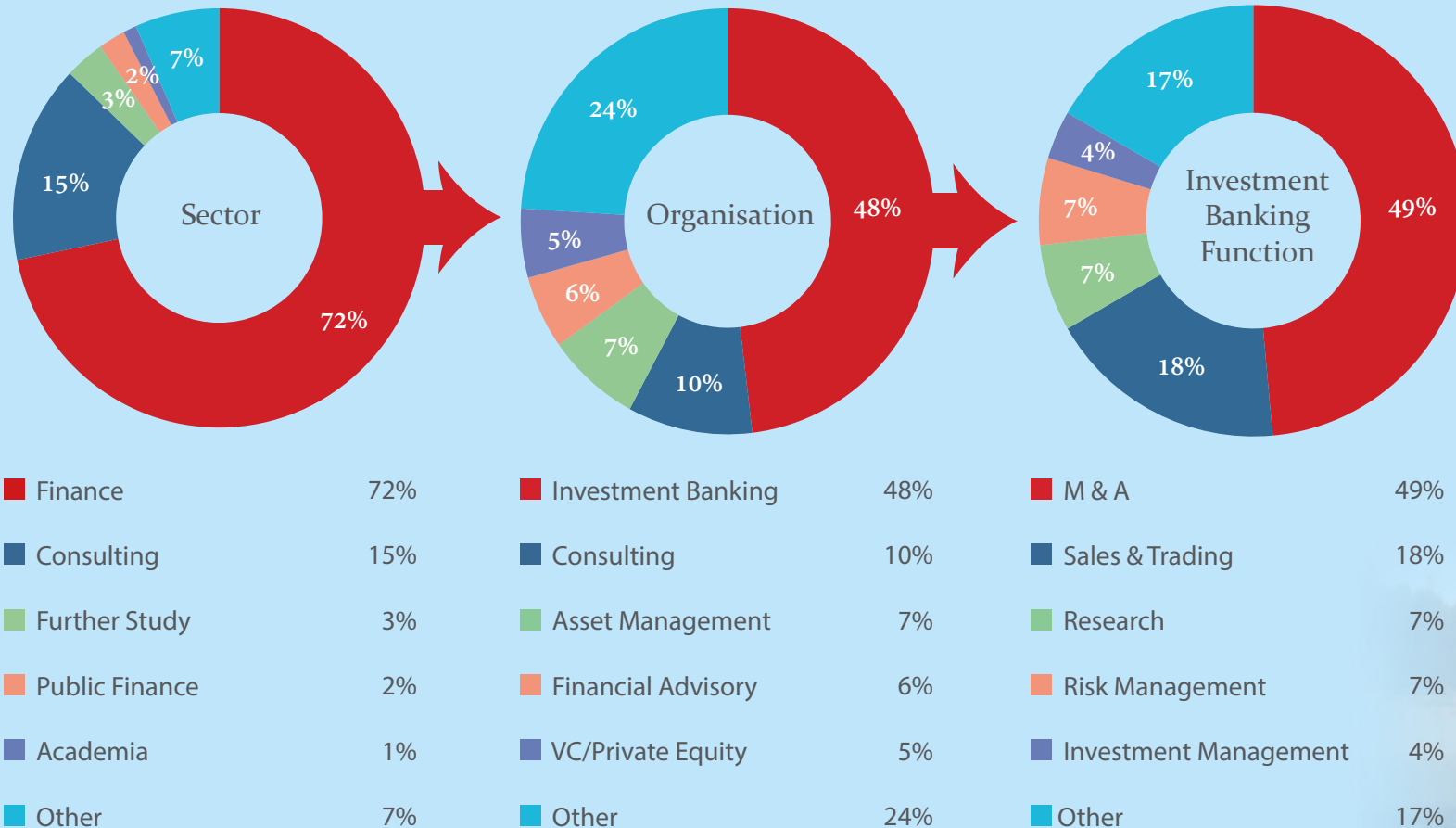


Latest classes profiles
