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#### **Other Private Sector**


Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) Manager, Public Affairs Manager, Regulatory Affairs Specialist, Geopolitical risk, due diligence, ESG roles.

#### Academic and Research Institutions

Research Fellow, Policy Researcher, academic careers, think tank roles

#### Consulting and Professional Services

Consultancy (big four, development, public policy, economic), international trade and regulatory affairs roles (in government, business associations)



#### Government and Public Sector

Policy Advisor, Civil Servant, Public Affairs Specialist, Diplomat, Researcher, other political roles

### International Organisations

Program Officer, Policy Analyst, Programme/ Project Manager, Development roles (development banks), advocacy and campaign roles

#### NGOs

Programme Officers / Managers (UN, NGOs, charities), Development roles (development banks), advocacy and campaign roles



## Example. Thinking about a sector: International Development

Each sector of interest will include different types of organisation with varying sources of funding, objectives and outcomes.

#### Careers in charities, NGOs and social impact

This sector guide outlines information on what a career in charity, NGO or social impact work could look like for you.

#### What is a career in charities, NGOs and social impact?

While often used interchangeably, charities, NGOs and social impact careers focus on addressing societal or environmental issues:

- Charities: In the UK, charities are formally registered non-profit organisations with a charitable purpose, such as poverty relief, health, education, or environmental protection. They rely heavily on donations, fundraising, and volunteers to deliver direct services and support to individuals and communities in need.
- Non-Governmental Organisations (NGOs): This is a broader term encompassing

### Sectors: developing your knowledge

#### Entry routes

- Consulting, international organisations, corporates, law, civil service
  - Strict application dates and processes; recruitment funnels
  - History of early engagement and experience in the sector
  - Off cycle internships and post-degree applications

#### Internships are critical for some sectors

- Marketing, creative industries, culture and heritage, journalism, charities and NGO's (stipend if you're lucky), political sector
- Internships demonstrate motivation & commitment; helping your CV

#### Importance of volunteering

 Critical for some careers – third sector, law. The Volunteer Centre in LSE Life can help!



### Finding opportunities

#### **Advertised roles**

- Direct employer adverts, recruitment consultancies, job sites
- Be aware of deadlines & timings
- Review regularly, rolling postings
- CareerHub & Careers blog

#### **Speculative applications**

- Research the organisation, develop contacts
- Tailor applications focus on what you can do for them

Network – for information & speculative applications

- Personal contacts

### **Graduate Programme or Graduate Job?**

## **Graduate Programme or 'Grad Scheme'**

- Tend to be offered by larger employers
- Hiring a cohort of recent graduates to fill roles across an organization
- Offers a structured training programme with the potential for progression
- Timelines are often earlier in the academic year to manage volume of applicants/recruitment process. Offers can be made 6-9 months before start date

#### **Graduate Job**

- Can be offered by any size of employer including start ups
- Hiring one individual graduate for an individual role
- Can provide structured training but not always
- Recruitment can happen at any point in the year
   "rolling recruitment"
- Less time between recruitment process, offer and start date – think about your availability to start working when applying

- Informational interviewing



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
