

Research Funding 2022 – 2023


The Grantham Research Institute on Climate Change and the Environment would like to thank all its funders and partners for their generous support.

During our financial year 2022-23, the Grantham Research Institute secured a total of £8,920,817 in new funding from organisations listed below.

This was comprised of £3,314,380 from from UK Research funders including Research Councils and other similar non UK Research Funding providers, £3,352,974 from charitable trusts and foundations, £1,616,686 from companies and corporate foundations, and £636,777 from other sources¹.
