


Research Funding 2023 – 2024

New Funding Secured (1 August 2023 to 31 July 2024)

During our financial year 2023-24, the Grantham Research Institute secured a total of £12,144,670 in new funding from organisations listed below.

This was comprised of £1,623,318 from UK Government and Research Council grants, £8,393,947 from charitable trusts and foundations, £1,673,405 from companies and corporate foundations, £180,000 from individual donors and £274,000 from other sources¹.
