

Graduate Teaching Assistant vacancy

The Department of International Development is seeking to appoint a Graduate Teaching Assistant who is able to make an important contribution to teaching, at postgraduate level, and research in international development.

The main duty of the GTA will be to assist in the running of seminars of the half unit course DV454 "Gender, labour markets and social change in the Global South: theory, evidence, public action".

We are looking for a candidate who has completed (or is close to completing) a PhD and who has a strong background in gender, labour markets and the global economy from an international development perspective. The likely workload will be two seminars a week.

The course is taught in the Lent Term (January-March), and it is usually taken by approximately 30 students. DV424 examines the relationship between women's access to labour market opportunities and their position within the family and community: the exploitation versus emancipation argument.
