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
RESEARCH QUESTIONS

- Effect of informal care on health behaviour
- Validity of IVs for informal care provision

DATA & METHODS

- ELSA (UK), 2002-2017
- Ages 45-69
- Instrumental Variables
 - Living parents (3 IVs)
 - Living siblings
- Mourifié & Wan (2017) IV validity test
- Lewbel (2012) instruments
- Robustness: PDS Lasso

RESULTS



CONCLUSIONS

- Instruments identify variation in timing, not incidence
- No evidence of negative effects of care provision on health behaviour
