MSCA Individual Fellowships fund early career researchers (**who already have a doctorate or equivalent research experience**) to undertake a research project of their choice. International mobility is essential and fellowships include personal and career development objectives. Applications must therefore be written jointly between the applicant, the prospective supervisor and the EFPU of LSE.

UK institutions are still eligible to apply to host MSCA Individual Fellowships under the terms of the Withdrawal Agreement until 31 December 2020. Evaluation will not be affected by Brexit. The terms of the withdrawal agreement also guarantee that selected projects will be funded by the EU for their full duration regardless of start and end dates. More information available here.
