


What happens if you make a disclosure of sexual harassment or violence?

This flowchart shows you the options available to you if you experience sexual violence or harassment. It covers routes to report an incident (if you choose to do so) and how to get support.

You can ask a <u>Safe Contact</u>, a <u>Student's Union Advisor</u> or someone from <u>Student Wellbeing Service</u> to go through the flowchart with you.

- * How you wish to proceed at each step is up to you. In exceptional circumstances, when you report to the Police, the School may also decide to act because of the duty of care to you or to other students, even if an internal sexual misconduct investigation is postponed. You'll be informed if this happens. Similarly, in exceptional circumstances, the School may choose to involve the Police to protect you and others from harm. You'll be informed of this.
- ** Precautionary measures based on risk can be taken by the School if you report to the Police (even if an internal sexual misconduct investigation is postponed).
