




Structure of the MPP curriculum


MPP Students (2022/3) – academic background

Undergraduate degrees







 - How to be a politician



Entry requirements:

- 5 + years relevant professional experience
- Upper second class honours (2:1) degree or equivalent in any discipline

Application deadlines:

- Rolling deadline, but we encourage applicants to apply as early as possible by our early deadline **12 January 2024**
- SPP scholarships a complete programme application must be submitted by 12 January 2024 (details on webpage)
