- Discuss with colleagues
- Look out for special issues/call for papers on your topic
- Use keyword searching in Scopus, Web of Science
- Journal selectors
- Check the <u>Directory of Open Access Journals</u> for open access journals
- Evaluate using readership, rigour and reach

## What to consider when choosing a journal

## Readership

- Subject coverage (general, niche, local, international)
- Audience
- Manuscript types

### Reach

- Indicators of impact
- Indexing (Scopus, Web of Science)
- Open access

## Rigour

- Peer review
- Expert editorial board
- Rejection rate

### **Other**


